REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report deals with personal matters about identifiable individuals who are being considered for appointment to the Moss Park Arena Board.

SUMMARY

City Council has authorized the City Clerk to shortlist, interview and recommend candidates to Community Councils for appointment to the Moss Park Arena Board. This report recommends one candidate for appointment to the board.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council appoint Pui See Ho to the Moss Park Arena Board, at pleasure of Council, for a term of office ending on April 2, 2030, and until a successor is appointed.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct that Confidential Attachments 1a and 1b remain confidential in their entirety as they relate to personal matters about identifiable individuals being considered for appointment to the Moss Park Arena.

COMMENTS

Composition of the Moss Park Arena Board

The board is composed of:

- The Councillor for Ward 13
- 9 public members, 1 of whom may be nominated by the Central Toronto Skating Club and 1 of whom may be nominated by the Moss Park House League
- 1 non-voting staff member from the Parks, Forestry and Recreation Division

There is currently one position under consideration

This vacancy is a result of the resignation of Alec Wieczorek effective April 8, 2026.

Term of office

The term of office for public appointees to the Moss Park Arena Board is four years. The member appointed will serve a term of office ending April 2, 2030, and until a successor is appointed.

The City Clerk recruits and recommends candidates for Arena Boards to Community Council

City Council has authorized the City Clerk to screen, interview and recommend candidates for the Moss Park Arena Board to the Toronto and East York Community Council.

City Clerk's Office staff conducted outreach to attract diverse, qualified individuals with relevant skills and qualifications. City Clerk's Office staff promoted the opportunity to professional and community organizations, on social media and with posters in the arena.

City Clerk's Office and Parks and Recreation staff shortlisted and interviewed candidates based on the City Council approved qualifications and eligibility criteria. Parks and Recreation staff were asked to participate on the panel given their relationship with the Moss Park Arena and community recreation programs and services in Toronto. The panel consisted of:

- Operation Support Officer, Community Recreation, Parks & Recreation
- People Services Consultant, Public Appointments, City Clerk's Office

The panel selected the recommended candidate by weighing candidate applications and interview performance, and the different perspectives and representation that each would bring to the board.

Staff are recommending one candidate for appointment

City Clerk's Office and Parks and Recreation staff are recommending one candidate for appointment to Moss Park Arena Board (see Attachment 1). This candidate demonstrated City Council approved qualifications for Moss Park Arena Board with the relevant knowledge and experience.
