RE: Installation of Traffic Calming Measures on Ennerdale Road

Dear Chair and Members of Toronto and East York Community Council,

Ennerdale Avenue runs south from Eglinton Avenue West and is a high traffic route connecting residents to many nearby locations. Currently, Ennerdale Avenue benefits from traffic calming measures south to Dynevor Road. I have heard from residents that speeding is a major problem on the stretch between Hatherley Road and Dynevor Road, which lacks the same traffic calming measures.

In response to these issues, a neighbourhood survey conducted by my office confirmed strong support for installing speed humps. These measures will help to reduce speeding and improve safety for all residents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation of traffic calming (two speed humps) on Ennerdale Road, between Rochdale Avenue and Chudleigh Road, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-700, dated May 2026 from the Director, Enforcement and Street Management, Transportation Services.
