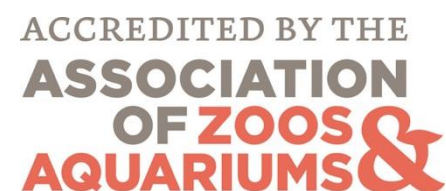

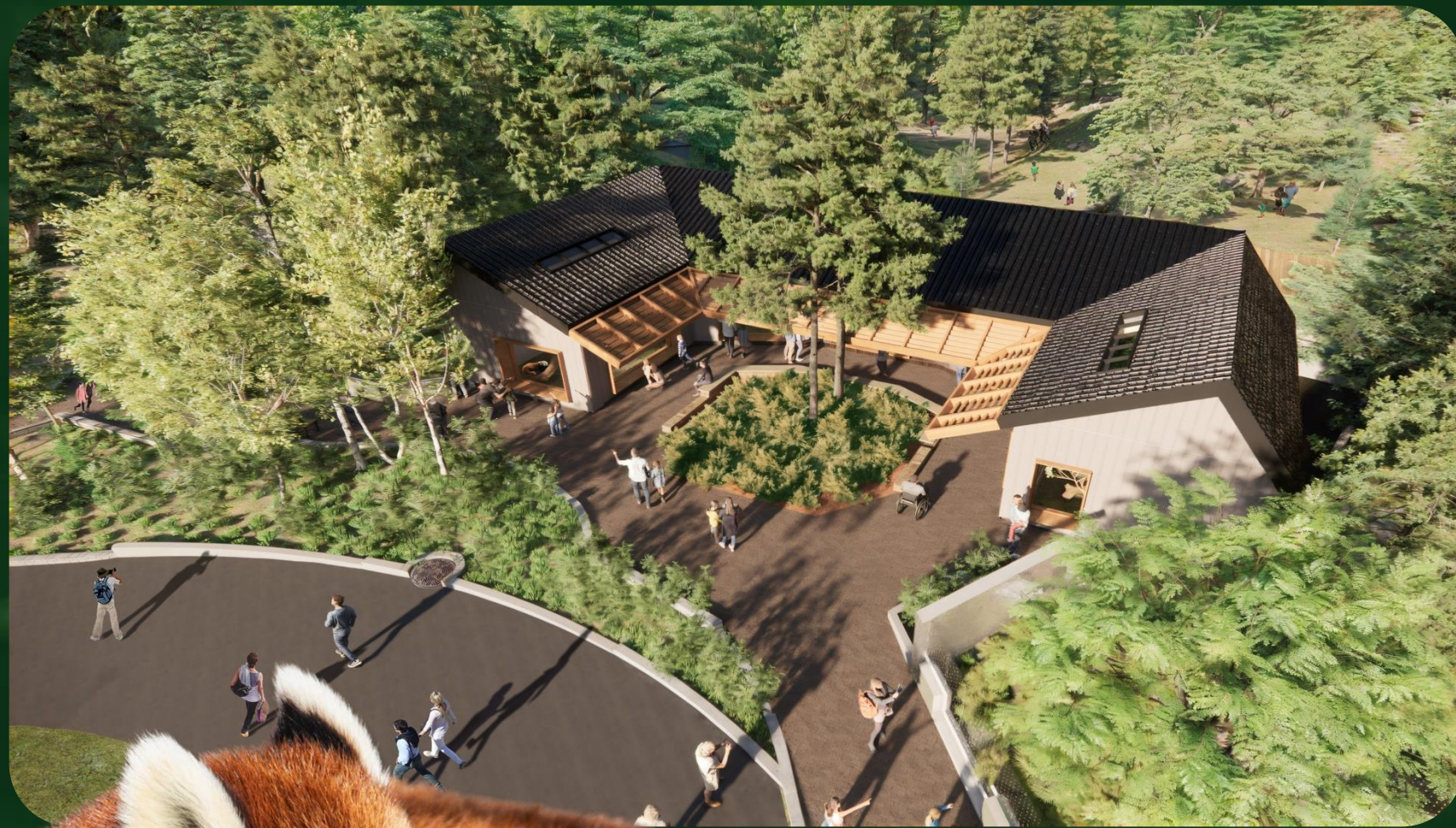

Wildlife Planning with *Purpose*

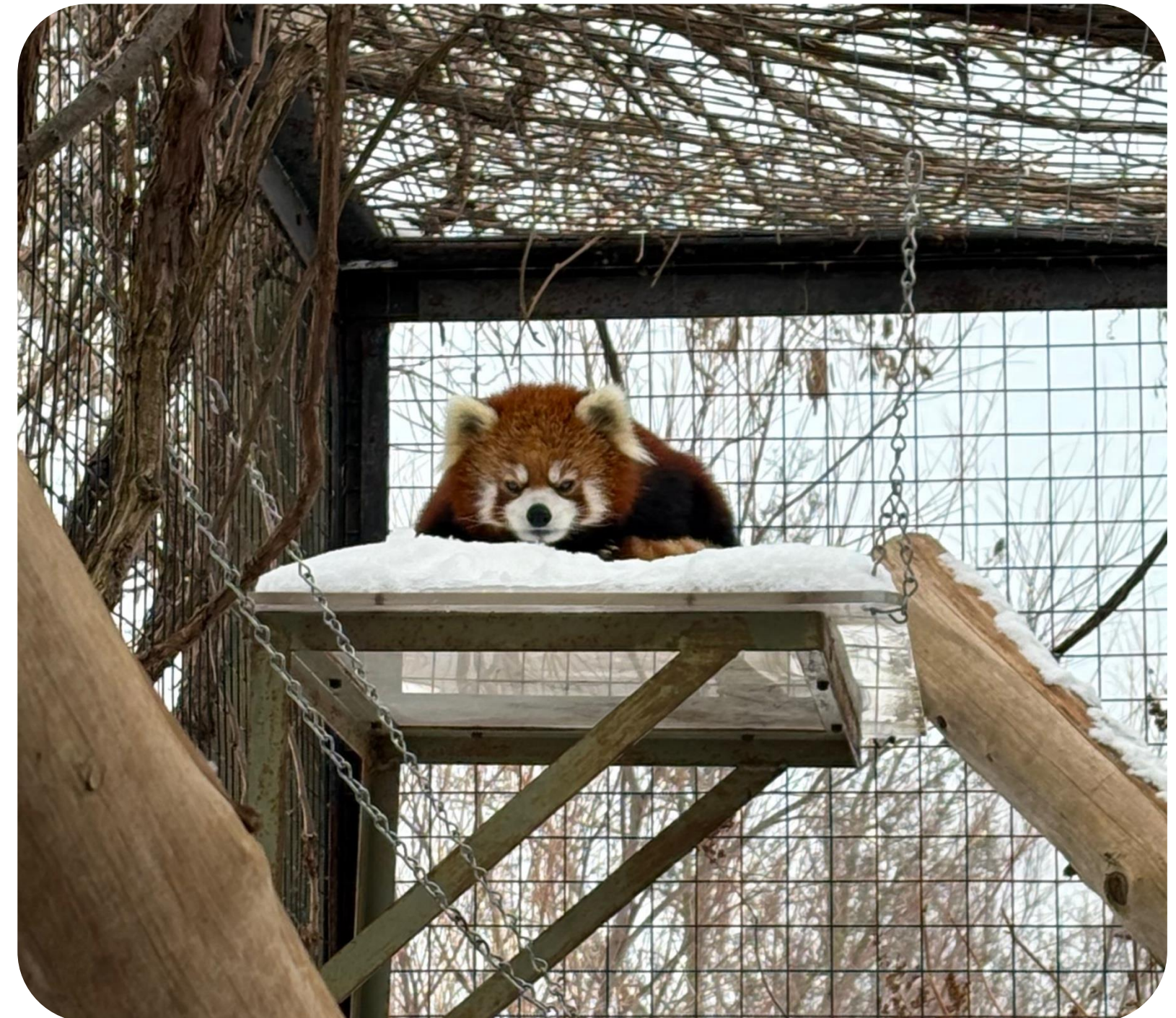
- Animal Lives with Purpose Plan, Succession planning

Temporary Red Panda Habitat – Africa Savanna

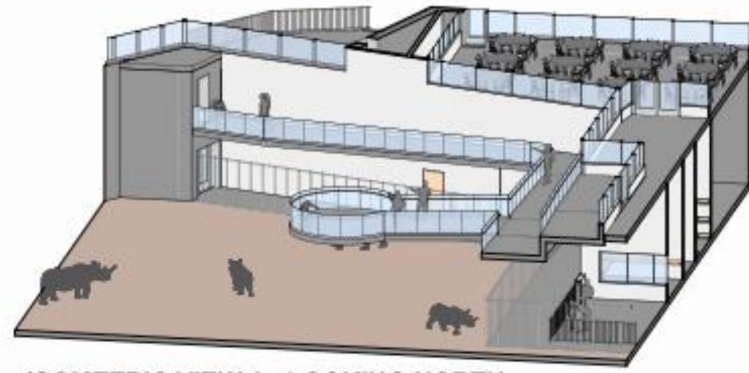

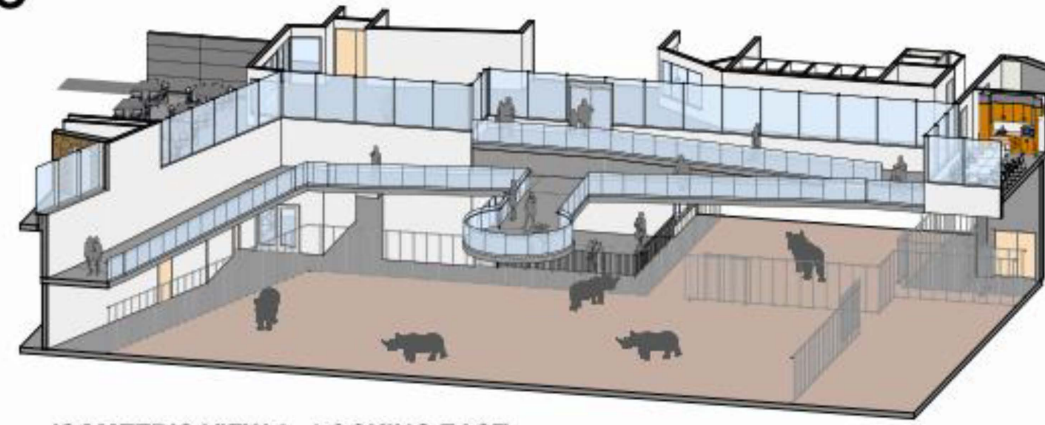




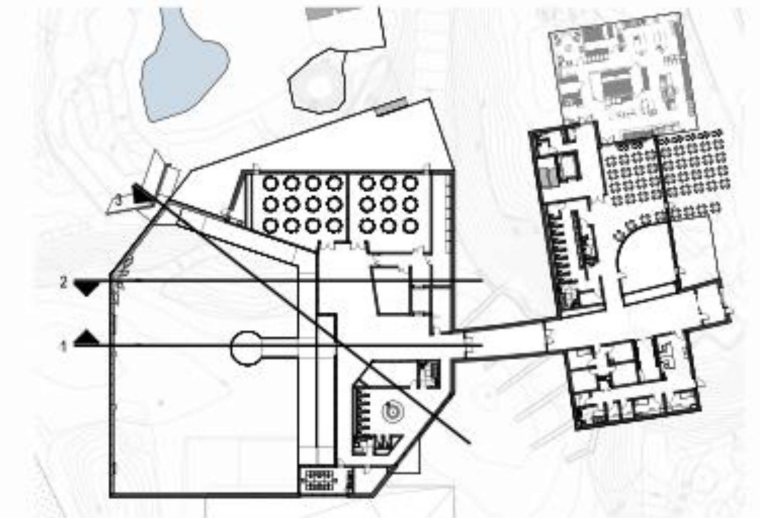

ISOMETRIC VIEW 2 - LOOKING EAST



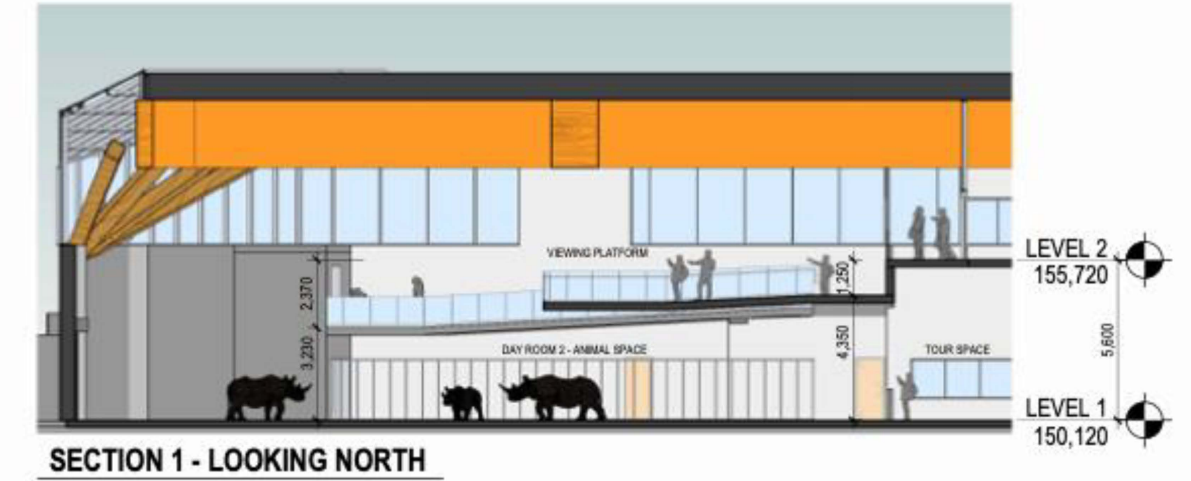

PERSPECTIVE VIEW 2 - FROM VIEWING PLATFORM @ L2 - 1.5m



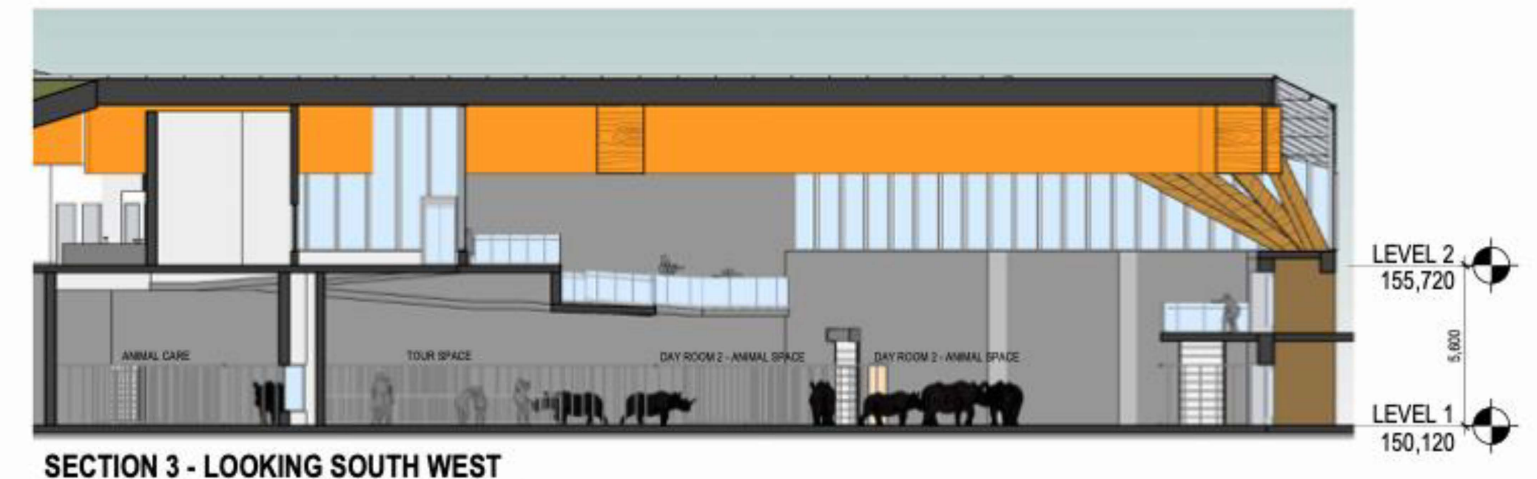
