SUMMARY

This report is intended to update the Board of Management on the disposal of surplus property at the Toronto Zoo.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Chief Transformation Officer recommends that:

1. The Board of Management of the Toronto Zoo receive this report for information.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

In 2025, the Toronto Zoo disposed of used vehicles and equipment, the net revenue from the sale of surplus property was \$68,166.36.

DECISION HISTORY

The proceeds of the sale or auction of items is reported to the Board of Management in accordance with Zoo Bylaw 2-2019, and the revenue is included in miscellaneous revenues. The net revenue generated varies each year depending on the number of surplus items as well as the quality of the items sent to auction.

COMMENTS

Throughout the year, the Toronto Zoo disposes of items that have been collected through un-claimed lost and found, furniture, equipment and vehicles that are surplus to

the Toronto Zoo's needs. Various items are deemed to be of no value and are donated to charities, recycled or sent to landfill. A list of surplus vehicles, equipment and furniture is prepared for sale and/or auction through North Toronto Auction.
