

No. 155—70. A BY-LAW

*To amend By-law No. 20623 by redesignating as G the area known as Sumach-Shuter Parkette.*

[Passed April 30, 1970.]

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Toronto enacts as follows:


1. Map No. 12 contained in Appendix "A" annexed to By-law No. 20623, being "A By-law To regulate the use of land and the erection, use, bulk, height, spacing of and other matters relating to buildings and structures and to prohibit certain uses of lands and the erection and use of certain buildings and structures in various areas of the City of Toronto", is amended by redesignating as G the areas described, Firstly and Secondly, in By-law No. 86-69 of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, which areas are now designated C.2 V.2.

2. This By-law shall not come into force without the approval of The Ontario Municipal Board.

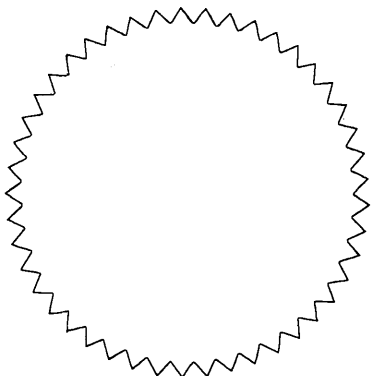


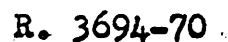

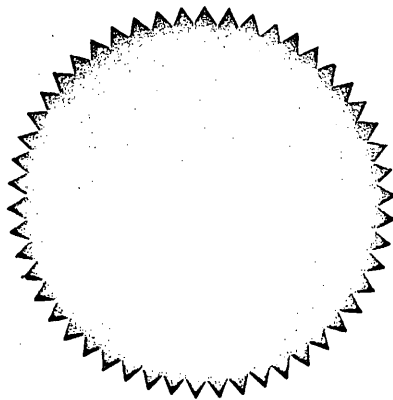
