The City of Toronto holds public consultations as one way to engage residents in the life of their city. We invite you to get involved.

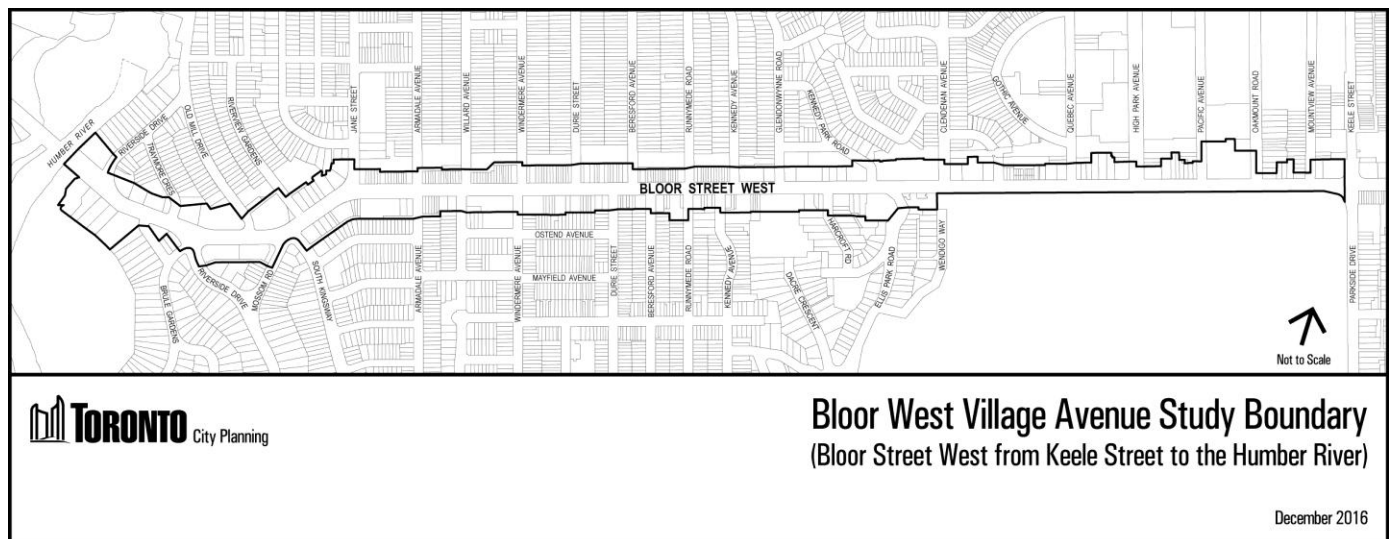
Bloor West Village Avenue Study

The City Planning Division is undertaking an Avenue Study for the properties fronting on Bloor Street West between Keele Street and the Humber River, as outlined on the map below. The Avenue Study will involve the analysis of existing buildings, zoning by-laws, land uses, parks, open spaces, transportation and servicing infrastructure, community services and other aspects related to the redevelopment of this corridor which is identified in the City's Official Plan to accommodate population growth.

The study will provide recommendations to implement the policy framework, which could include area-wide zoning changes, area-specific planning tools and policies, area-specific urban design guidelines, road/pedestrian/cycling network improvements particularly around TTC stations, infrastructure improvements and a Community Services and Facilities Strategy.

The City is holding a Community Consultation meeting where you can learn more about this Avenue Study, ask questions and share feedback about existing conditions, opportunities, and ideas you'd like to see considered in the study.
