**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

1713812 Ontario Inc.'s licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years to commence on January 14, 2016;
- (2) Prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, 1713812 Ontario Inc., Towtal Roadside Solutions Inc. and Mr. Pereira must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at their own expense, updated abstracts of their driving record and criminal record check;
- (3) During the probationary period, if 1713812 Ontario Inc., Towtal Roadside Solutions Inc. or Mr. Pereira incur any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days. The notification shall include their ML&S licence number and the ticket number(s). Mr. Pereira can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:

- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6490, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**2. Nuno Miguel Bettencourt Fernandes (Report No. 6470)**  
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B538905)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint settlement:

Nuno Miguel Bettencourt Fernandes' application (No. B538905), found at page 112 of Report No. 6470, for a new tow truck driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) A valid criminal record check to be successfully filed with Municipal Licensing and Standards within two weeks of today's date;
- (2) If the valid criminal record check is not filed within two weeks of today's date, Mr. Bettencourt Fernandes has a further two-week period (to February 20, 2016) to communicate with Municipal Licensing and Standards a continued intention to pursue the issuance of his tow truck driver's licence and Municipal Licensing and Standards will respond accordingly; otherwise the application will be deemed withdrawn;
- (3) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year to commence on date of issuance;
- (4) Prior to the next renewal of the licence, Mr. Bettencourt Fernandes must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of driving record and criminal record check;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Mr. Bettencourt Fernandes incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days. The notification shall include his ML&S licence number and the ticket number(s). Mr. Bettencourt Fernandes can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:
