Pharmacists' expanded scope of practice in relation to vaccines

Starting December 15, 2016 pharmacists will be able to administer additional non-publicly funded vaccines indicated in the table below.

- Clients who choose to receive vaccines from a participating pharmacist has to be five years of age and older; will have to pay for the vaccine and an administration fee.
- Pharmacists will not have to access to any publicly funded vaccines with the exception of influenza.
- Individuals who meet the eligibility criteria listed below can receive publicly funded vaccine from their primary care provider.
