5. Levito Ramzy De Lambert (Report No. 6372)
Holder of Taxicab Driver (Vehicle-For-Hire) Licence No. D01-3129708

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint Proposed Resolution:

Levito Ramzy De Lambert's taxicab driver (Vehicle-For-Hire) licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence will be cancelled;
- (2) The licence shall immediately be suspended for a period of two (2) days, commencing on the date that this resolution is approved by the Tribunal and the licensee must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (3) The licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on the date that this proposed resolution is approved by the Tribunal;
- (4) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Mr. De Lambert must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original updated abstract of his driving record and criminal records check within 30 days of the licence expiry date, failing which the licence will be suspended until such document is received to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6372, and any updating material shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
