**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: March 5, 2015**

- 1. Always Fresh Restaurant Inc.** (Report No. 6223)  
o/a Always Fresh Restaurant  
Paul Augustus Barrows, President  
Applicant for an Eating Establishment Licence (Application No. B419229)

**DECISION:**

Always Fresh Restaurant Inc.'s eating establishment licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Barrows must provide evidence to Municipal Licensing and Standards that any fines outstanding or due against him are fully paid;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on March 5, 2015;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Barrows must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Barrows incurs any new criminal charges or convictions, or of any new charges or convictions under any by-law, or under the *Liquor Licence Act*, or under any Food Safety or Public Health Legislation, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
  - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;
  - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;
  - via email to [mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca](mailto:mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca); or
  - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6223, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing;
- (6) Delroy Barrows is not permitted to be on the business premises or otherwise involved in the business.
