DECISION:

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to March 3, 2016, *peremptory* to Mr. Francia.

- 3. Samantha Lin Anderson** (Report No. 6528)
Applicant for an Entertainer Licence (Application No. B543326)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution, **as amended:**

Samantha Lin Anderson's entertainer licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year to commence on February 18, 2016;

- (2) Prior to the next renewal of the licence, Ms. Anderson must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated abstract of her criminal record;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Ms. Anderson incurs any new charges or convictions under the Toronto Municipal Code or Criminal Code, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days. The notification shall include her ML&S licence number and the ticket number(s). Ms. Anderson can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6528, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered an amendment to the Proposed Resolution: Ms. Anderson's outstanding licensing fee must be paid to Municipal Licensing and Standards by end of business today.

4. Sibtain Akhtar (Report No. 6283)

Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3596126

DECISION:

Sibtain Akhtar's licence will have the following conditions imposed, effective immediately:

- (1) The licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of sixty (60) days, to commence on February 18, 2016; and **the licensee must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;**
- (2) The licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years to commence on February 18, 2016;
- (3) Prior to each of the next four (4) renewals of the licence, Mr. Akhtar must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated Ministry of Transportation driver's abstract, to be submitted within three days of the following date:

February 18, 2016

- April 18, 2016
 - August 31, 2016
 - February 23, 2017
 - August 31, 2017
 - February 22, 2018
 - August 31, 2018
 - February 28, 2019
 - August 31, 2019
 - February 18, 2020
- (4) During the probationary period, if Sibtain Akhtar incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days. The notification shall include his ML&S licence number and the ticket number(s). Mr. Akhtar can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:
