Applicant for Renewal of Retail Store (Food) Licence No. B50-4315337

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly Proposed Resolution:

Joe's Garden Centre & Grapes' licence will have the following conditions imposed, effective immediately;

- (1) The licence will be immediately renewed and suspended for a period of ten (10) days, which suspension shall commence on March 10, 2017;
- (2) The licence shall be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years to commence on December 8, 2016;
- (3) Prior to each of the next four (4) renewals of the licence, the licensee (Joe's Garden Centre & Grapes) must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of the criminal record of Mr. Jason Silva;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application/licence will be cancelled;
- (2) The taxicab driver's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of six (6) days, to commence on December 8, 2016; and Mr. Sahal must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (3) The licences will be placed on probation until November 10, 2019 to commence on December 8, 2016;

- (4) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licences, Mr. Sahal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Mr. Sahal incurs any new charges and/or convictions under the Toronto Municipal Code or the Highway Traffic Act; or if Mr. Sahal's provincial driver's licence is suspended, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days.
