DECISION:

Abdul Wakil Omarzadah's taxicab owner's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year to commence on July 28, 2016;
- (2) During the probationary period, the following driving restriction imposed on Mr. Abdul Wakil Omarzadah's taxicab owner's licence by the Toronto Licensing Tribunal on June 2, 2016 will continue:
 - Mr. Omarzadah is not permitted to drive unless the vehicle is equipped with an in-car camera; and he is not to enter any fares' residences;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Mr. Omarzadah incurs any new charges and/or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days. Mr. Omarzadah can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:
