URGENT DENTAL CONDITIONS

Must be seen the SAME DAY or WITHIN 24 hours by a dentist


Swelling (extraorally or intraorally) with or without pain







Abscess + pain that cannot be controlled with analgesics. NOTE : However if pain is manageable with analgesics, patient must be seen within 3 days.





Cavities (big or small; single or multiple) + pain that cannot be controlled with analgesics. NOTE: However if pain is manageable with analgesics, patient must be seen within 3 days.







Rampant caries in very young children: NOTE: Parents may report that the child is irritable, refusing to eat, drink, or refusing to open mouth instead of complaining about pain.
