
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: June 29, 2017
Summary of Decisions

1. **Bilal Basrah** (Report No. 6867)

Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B707335)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following Proposed Resolution:

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's licence will be issued to Bilal Basrah, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application/licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on June 29, 2017;
- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Bilal Basrah must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Bilal Basrah, those matters and report No. 6867, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. **Ryaz Mohmand** (Report No. 6545)

Applicant for renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-3957699

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following Proposed Resolution:

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application/licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 29, 2017;
- (3) Prior to each of the next three (3) renewals of the licence, Ryaz Mohmand must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Ryaz Mohmand, those matters and report no. 6545, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. **Gurnam Singh** (Report No. 6814)

Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B689375)

And

Applicant for renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3617013

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following Proposed Resolution:

Gurnam Singh will have the following interim conditions imposed on his Taxicab Owner's Licence, effective immediately:

- (1) If Mr. Singh incurs any new charges under the Highway Traffic Act, and the Criminal Code of Canada, Municipal Licensing and Standards reserves the right, prior to the resolution of any outstanding criminal charges, to bring any such new charges and an updated report No. 6814 before the Tribunal for a hearing prior to October 5, 2017;
- (2) If Mr. Singh incurs any new charges related to impaired operations of a motor vehicle, his driving privileges will be immediately suspended;
- (3) At any point prior to the Tribunal's final disposition of this matter, Municipal Licensing and Standards or Mr. Singh may seek leave from the Tribunal to amend the conditions imposed on the licence if the present facts or circumstances surrounding this matter change. The party requesting leave must serve notice of such request on the other party;
- (4) That this matter be adjourned to October 5, 2017, following the resolution

of the criminal charges currently before the Criminal Courts.

With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered an amendment to paragraph 4: Tribunal hearing is adjourned to October 26, 2017.

4. Kashif Saeed (Report No.6540)

Applicant for the renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4070069

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following Proposed Resolution:

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's licence will be renewed to Kashif Saeed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application/licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on June 29, 2017;
- (3) The licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of four (4) days, to commence on a date to be determined by the Toronto Licensing Tribunal; and the licensee must **surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;**
- (4) Prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Kashif Saeed must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Kashif Saeed, those matters and report No. 6540, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered that Mr. Saeed's vehicle-for-hire licence will be suspended for four (4) days and Mr. Saeed must hand in his photo card and licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards by Friday, June 30, 2017 before 9:00 a.m.

**5. Varinder Singh Boparai (Report No.6529)
(a.k.a. Varinder Singh)**

Applicant for the Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4423012;
Plate No.659

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following Proposed resolution:

Taxicab Owner's licence will be renewed to Varinder Singh Boparai, effective immediately, subject to following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of June 29, 2017, failing which the application/licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Mr. Boparai is not to drive a taxicab or limousine;

With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered an amendment to paragraph 2: Mr. Boparai is not to drive a Taxicab or Limousine in a business capacity.

6. Jamie Lee Howell (Report No.6811)

Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No.B692463)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following Proposed Resolution:

Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be issued to Jamie Lee Howell, effective immediately subject to following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application/licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 29, 2017;
- (3) Prior to each of the next three (3) renewals of the licence, Jamie Lee Howell must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his criminal record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Jamie Lee

Howell, those matters and report No. 6811, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing

7. Ravi Sharma (Report No.6538)

Applicant for Renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence D01-4315929

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following conditions:

Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's licence will be renewed to Ravi Sharma, effective immediately subject to following conditions:

- (1) Immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended for (15) days commencing on June 29, 2017 and the licensee must return his photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards tomorrow June 30, 2017 by mail or courier.
- (2) The terms of probation currently on the licence that require reporting of new charges and convictions has now been lifted;
- (3) The terms of probation that was placed on Mr. Sharma's licence at the Tribunal hearing on May 8, 2014, set to expire on October 17, 2017, will be extended for another 3 years to October 17, 2020;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6538, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

7. Sathyanathan Maheswaran (Report No.6445)

Holder of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence D01-3356925

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to July 13, 2017. Tribunal staff are to contact Mr. Maheswaran to inform him of his hearing date.
