Riverside Drive Road Reconstruction Public Open House #2

The City of Toronto is reconstructing Riverside Drive from South Kingsway to Brule Gardens, and resurfacing Riverside Crescent, to bring the streets to a state of good repair. We invite you to attend the second public open house to learn about the design, ask questions, and provide feedback.

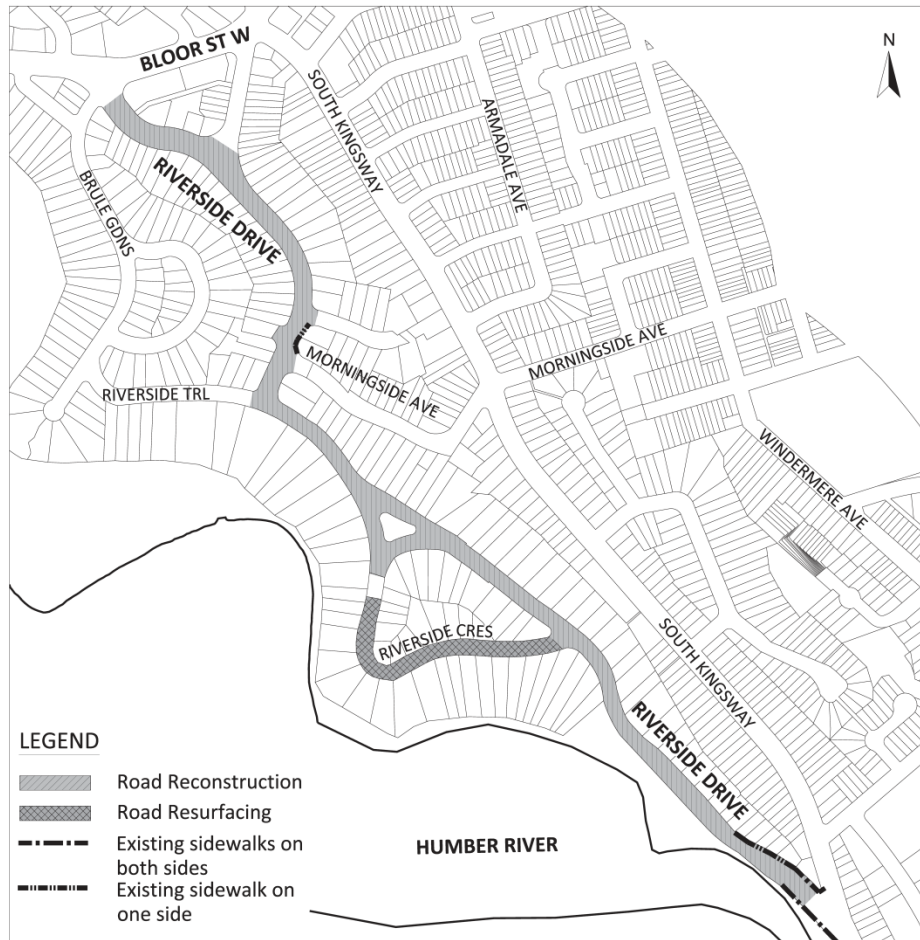
During the first public open house (February 25, 2016), the City presented preliminary designs for Riverside Drive. Thank you to everyone who attended the open house and shared comments afterwards. Insight provided by local residents helped to shape the next iteration of the design, which will be presented at the second public open house. This event will provide an opportunity for you to comment on the revised design and share your insights on how Riverside Drive could be improved.

The reconstruction of Riverside Drive will include:

- Replacing the existing retaining wall at the south end of the street to upgrade the aging structure and stabilizing the slope
- Narrowing the roadway
- Replacing the painted road markings at Riverside Drive and Mossum Road with extended boulevard and landscaping
- Greening the street with additional plants and trees
- Replacing the watermain and substandard water services where required
- Connecting the pedestrian network in the neighbourhood by constructing a sidewalk
- Constructing curbs, gutters, and a boulevard
- Enhancing storm water management, including installing permeable pavers at certain sections

Riverside Crescent will be resurfaced as part of this project.
