All dogs and cats living in Toronto must be licensed with Toronto Animal Services and wear the City-issued tag. Licences can also be purchased or renewed online.

- Failure to license a dog or cat every year may result in a \$240 ticket. If you are taken to court, the maximum penalty is a \$5.000 fine.
