**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: April 27, 2017**  
**Summary of Decisions**

- 1. Thapi Mehanathan** (Report No. 6762)  
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B684301)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following jointly Proposed Resolution:

Mr. Thapi Mehanathan's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on April 27, 2017;
- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Mr. Mehanathan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Mehanathan, those matters and report no. 6762 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

- 2. Nidaulhaq Abidi** (Report No. 6833)  
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B701248)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following jointly Proposed Resolution:

Mr. Nidaulhaq Abidi's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on April 27, 2017;
- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Mr. Abidi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Abdi, those matters and report No. 6833, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**3. Ramy Abdalla Musa (Report No. 6810)**

Applicant for a Vehicle-for-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B691443) and; Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4316645; Taxicab Plate No. 2332

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following jointly Proposed Resolution:

Mr. Ramy Abdalla Musa's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on April 27, 2017;
- (3) Prior to each of the next three (3) renewals of the licence, Mr. Musa must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Musa, those matters and report No. 6810, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**4. Abdulsalam Shahmeh** (Report No. 6831)  
Applicant for a Vehicle-for-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. B701250)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following jointly Proposed Resolution:

Mr. Abdulsalam Shahmeh's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year to commence on April 27, 2017;
- (3) Prior to the next renewal of the licence, Mr. Shahmeh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Shahmeh, those matters and report no. 6831, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**5. Benny Kam Cheong Yuen** (Report No. 6804)  
Holder of Driving Instructor's Licence No. V11-3475551)

**DECISION:**

Mr. Benny Kam Cheong Yuen's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended until Mr. Yuen provides proof of a reinstatement of his Provincial Driving Instructor's Licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards;
- (2) If Mr. Yuen is unable to provide proof of a reinstatement of his Provincial Driving Instructor's Licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards by the next licence renewal date of April 1, 2018, his City of Toronto Driving Instructor's Licence will be cancelled.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following jointly Proposed Resolution:

Mr. Ghulam Mohammed Alakoozi's licences will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on April 27, 2017;
- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Mr. Alakoozi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his driving record;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mr. Alakoozi, those matters and report No. 6774, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B656347)

**DECISION:**
