TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: September 10, 2015 Summary of Decisions N. Treksler / A. Alibhai / A. Walsh

1. Anowarul Hoque (Report No. 6296)

Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2012086; and Applicant for a Taxicab Owner's Licence (Application No. B425358)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

Anowarul Hoque will have the following conditions imposed on his licence, effective immediately:

- (1) Mr. Hoque's licence No. D01-2012086 shall be cancelled and a new Toronto taxicab owner's licence issued and immediately suspended for a period of four (4) days, to commence on September 10, 2015; and the licensee must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) Prior to the next renewal of his taxicab owner's licence, Mr. Hoque shall complete, at his own expense, an anger management course and shall submit a proof of completion of such course to Municipal Licensing and Standards, and such proof shall be in the form of an official certificate or a letter on an official letterhead from the course provider;
- (3) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on September 10, 2015;
- (4) prior to each of the next three (3) renewals of the licence, Mr. Hoque must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Hoque incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code of Canada*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;

- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6296, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
- Estate of John Markovich (Report No. 6476) Karen Markovich, Estate Trustee Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4314574 for Taxicab Plate No. 1322

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4314574 for taxicab plate No. 1322 in the Estate of John Markovich to February 1, 2016.

3. Gurpreet Singh Kang (Report No. 6410) Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B535394)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

Gurpreet Singh Kang's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on September 10, 2015;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Kang must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record; every six (6) months for the first year and then yearly on renewal;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Kang incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days. The notification shall include his ML&S licence number and the ticket number(s). Mr. Kang can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;

(4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6410, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
