- 1. Ahilakumaran Poopalasingham** (Report No. 6403)
Applicant for a Limousine Driver's Licence (Application No. B535940)

DECISION:

The Tribunal denied Ahilakumaran Poopalasingham's application (No. B535940) for a limousine driver's licence.

- 2. Michael Tommy Welna** (Report No. 6304)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B427746)

DECISION:

The Tribunal deemed Michael Tommy Welna's application (No. B427746) as abandoned.

(Mr. Welna did not attend today's hearing).

- 3. Estate of Sarah Carman** (Report No. 6487)
Haydn Fried, Estate Trustee
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4429902 for Taxicab Plate No. 1431

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4429902 for taxicab plate No. 1431 in the Estate of Sarah Carman for a period of three (3) months.

4. Estate of Tova Himelfarb (Report No. 6486)

Ronald Himelfarb, Estate Trustee

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4538241 for Taxicab Plate No. 1850

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4538241 for taxicab plate No. 1850 in the Estate of Tova Himelfarb for a period of nine (9) months.

5. Bashar Kazi (Report No. 6429)

Applicant for a Limousine Driver's Licence (Application No. B531847)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

Bashar Kazi's limousine driver's licence will be issued effective immediately. The limousine and taxicab driver's licence will have the following conditions imposed, effective immediately:

- (1) the licences shall be immediately suspended for a period of one (1) day, to commence on September 24, 2015; and the licensee must **surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;**
- (2) Mr. Kazi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) the licences will be placed on probation **until February 13, 2016** to commence on September 24, 2015;
- (4) prior to the next renewal of the licence, Mr. Kazi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Kazi incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;

- via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;
- via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
- via fax at 416-392-3102

(6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6429, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Kazi to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.

6. Shakayla Taeshia Downey (Report No. 6415)
Applicant for an Entertainer Licence (Application No. B536337)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

Shakayla Taeshia Downey's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on September 24, 2015;
- (2) Ms. Downey must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Ms. Downey must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated abstract of her criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Ms. Downey incurs any new charges or convictions under *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days. The notification shall include her ML&S licence number and the ticket number(s). Ms. Downey can notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in one of the following ways:
