PARTIAL INTERSECTION CLOSURE Lake Shore Blvd West @ Legion Road

Streetcar Track Replacement on Lake Shore Blvd West

Closure Start Date: 9:00AM Friday, October 27, 2017 Closure End Date: 6:00AM Monday October 30, 2017

*Timeline is subject to change.

The City contractor's work on Lake Shore Boulevard West continues. In order to safely remove and replace the track allowance on a section of the street, the intersection of Lake Shore Blvd West at Legion Road will be partially closed for track replacement.

This work will take place from 9:00 AM Friday, October 27 to 6AM Monday, October 30, 2017. Further update regarding the remaining work will be delivered in the coming weeks.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



This intersection work will take place around the clock during the closure.

- The loudest portion of work is on the first day when breaking and removing concrete. This type of work will stop at 11:00 p.m.
- The work hours will be split between the City's contractor and TTC staff working on the track replacement.
- Other work will take place over night. The overnight rail work by TTC may consist of moving new rail into position, rail installation and rail welding / grinding and concrete pouring/curing. Afterhours work by TTC is required to support the daytime construction and complete work more efficiently.

Regular work hours on this project will resume on Monday October 30th.



Traffic Management:

- Eastbound and Westbound traffic on Lake Shore Blvd West will be maintained in the curb lanes through the intersection.
- Southbound traffic on Legion Road can turn right onto Westbound Lake Shore Blvd West only with no left turns permitted to Eastbound Lake Shore Blvd
- Residents from 2261 Lake Shore Blvd West will only be able to turn right to enter and exit their driveway.

Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.



TTC Service:

501/301 Queen and 145 Downtown/Humber Bay Express buses on Lake Shore Blvd W will be maintained through the intersection. TTC Route/Schedules/Fares: 416-393-4636 or visit ttc.ca.



Pedestrian Access:

No pedestrian crossing will be maintained at the intersection of Legion Road and Lake Shore Blvd west. Pedestrians must walk to Park Lawn Rd to cross Lake Shore Blvd West.



Accommodation: Residents that require accommodation must contact the Project Information Line to arrange for access during construction.




Businesses will be open throughout construction. All are welcome to dine and shop locally.
