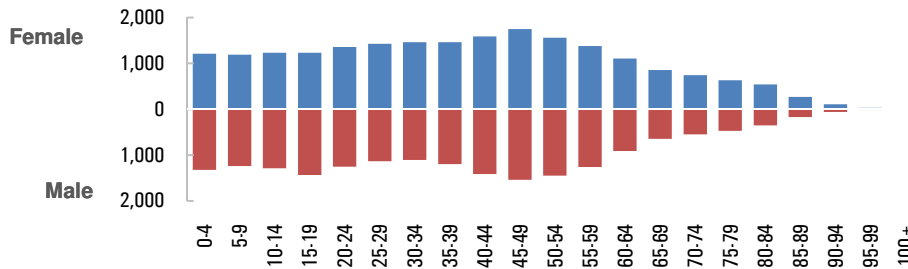

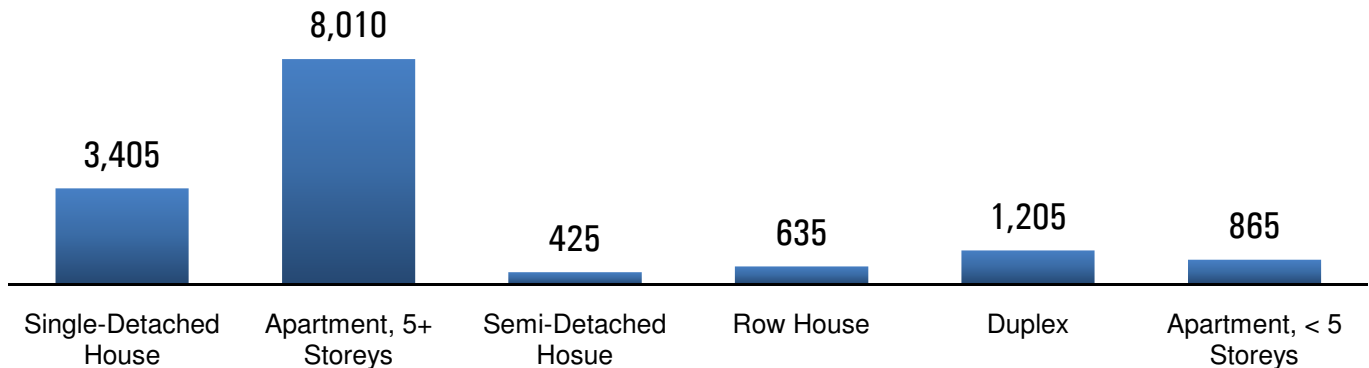

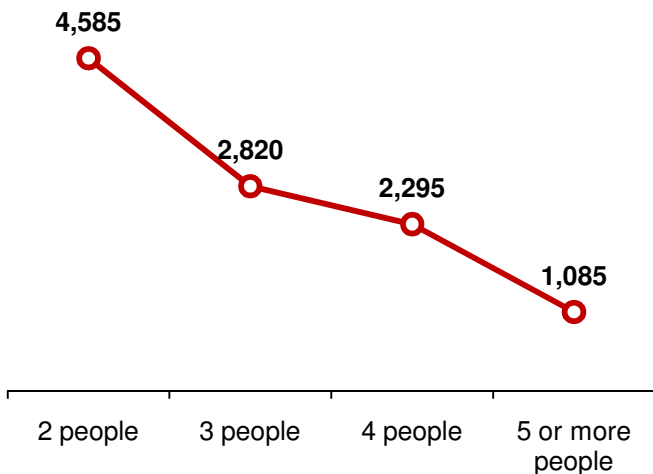

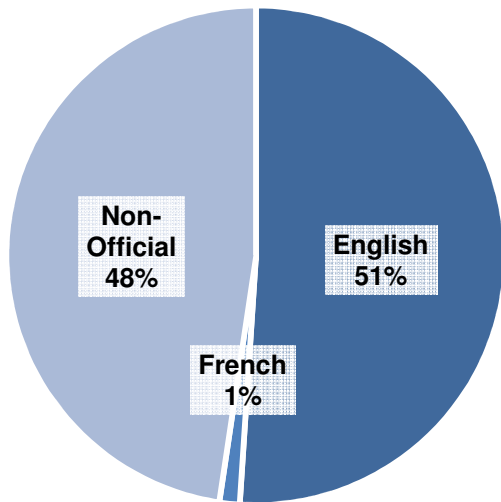

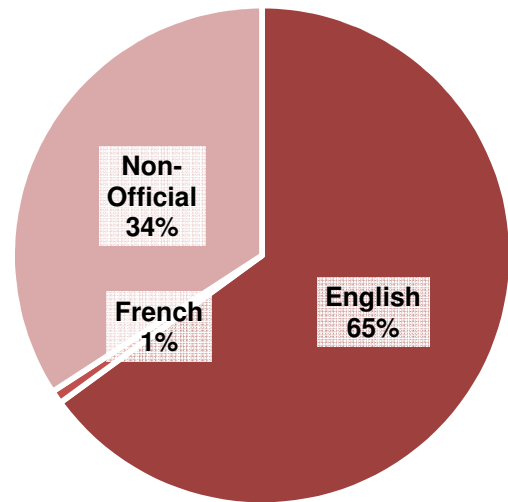

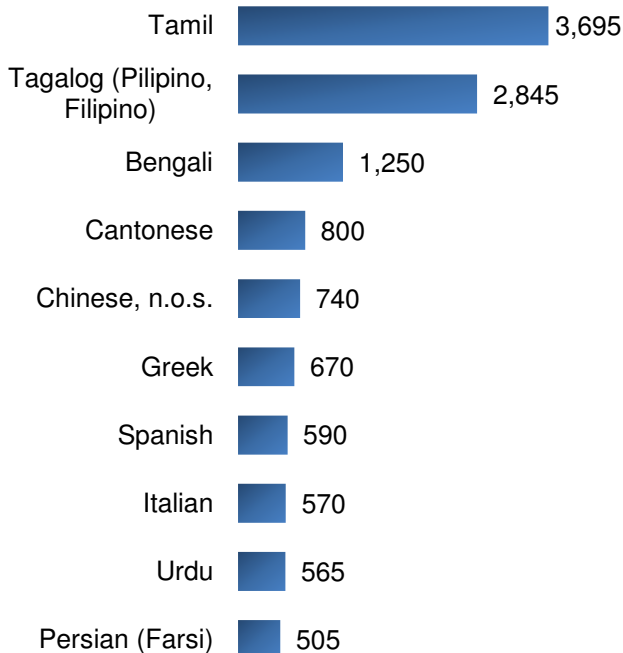
**Mother Tongue**



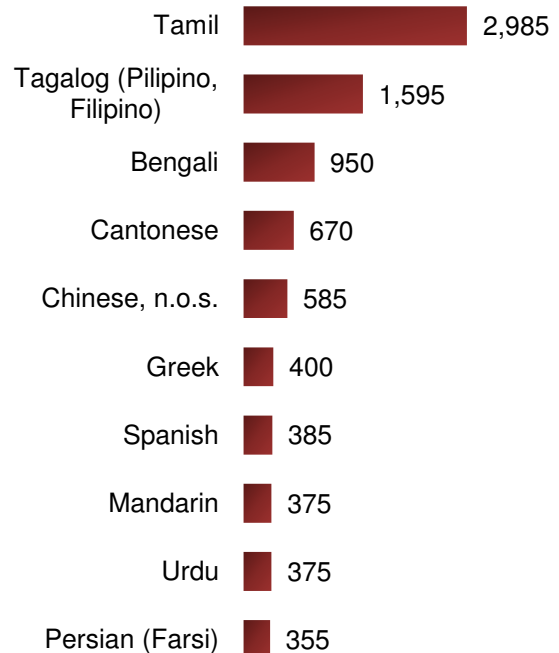
**Home Language**



**Top-10 Non-Official Mother Tongue Languages**



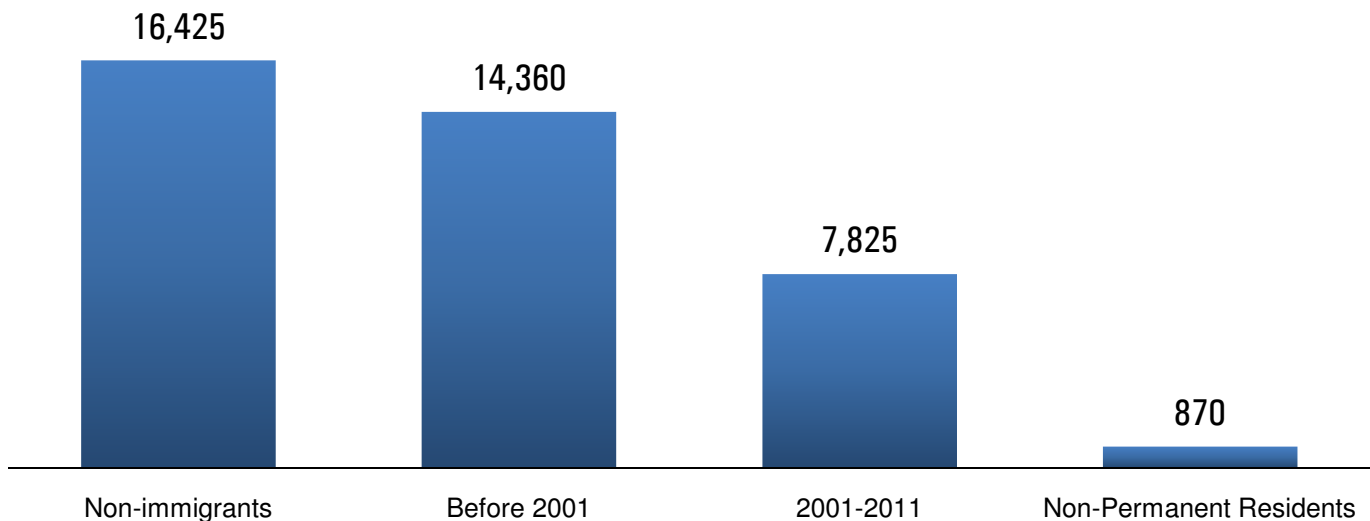
**Top-10 Non-Official Home Languages**



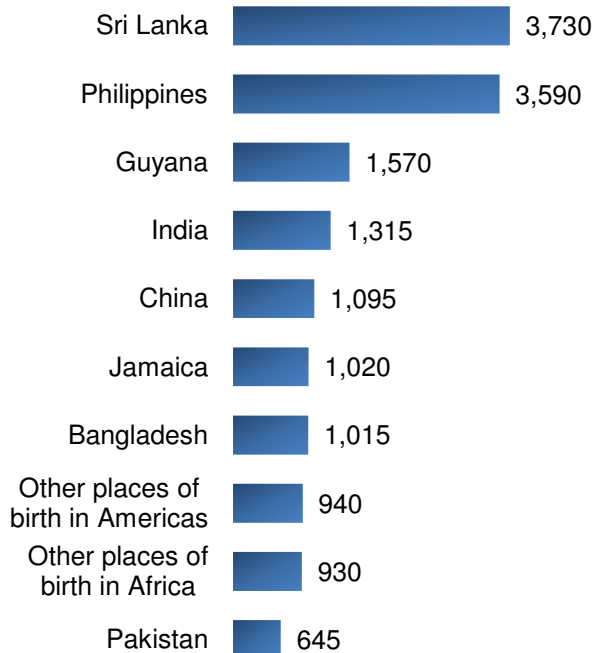

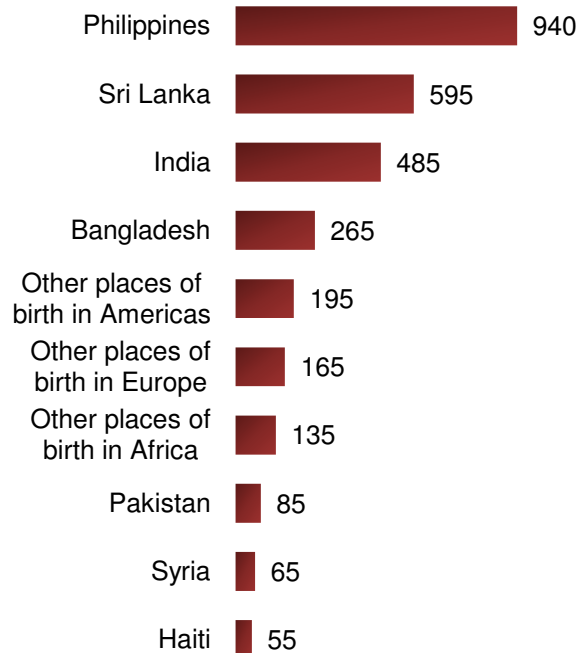
## Year Arrived in Canada



## Top-10 Birth Country for All Immigrants



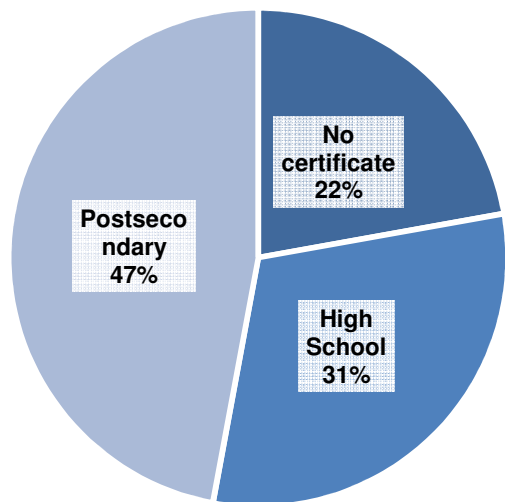
## Top-10 Birth Country for Recent Immigrants

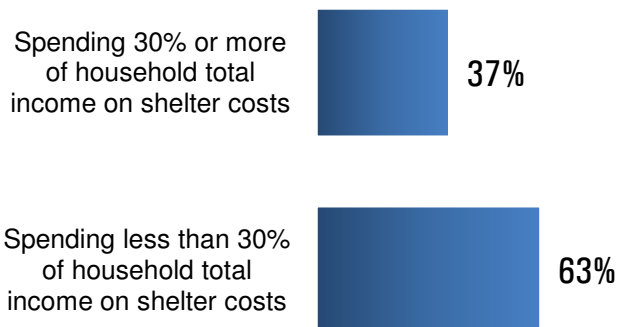

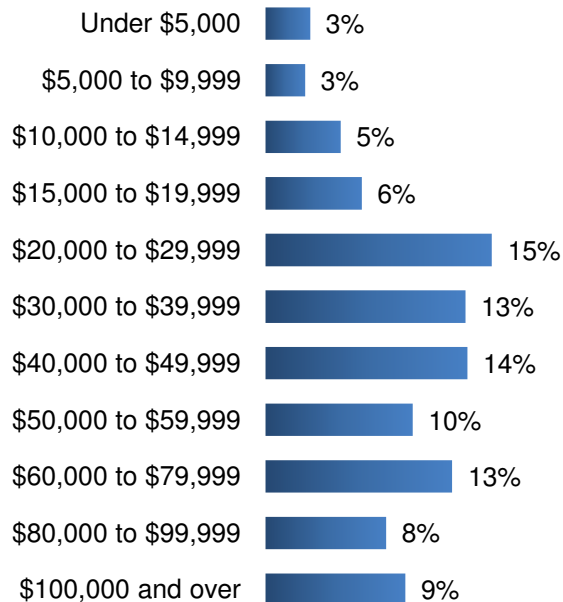
