

#### Street Sign Objectives

- Establish a clearly legible message hierarchy for St. Names, St. Numbers, Districts & BIA's.
- Coordinate design with overall streetscape improvements.
- Raise the quality standards of street sign design, construction method and modes of attachment.
- Provide groundwork for future system expansion.



### Street Sign Challenges

- Accommodate wide range of message lengths.
- Integrate District and BIA branding.
- Fasten securely to a myriad of lamp pole and post conditions.
- Coordinate with streetscape programs throughout Toronto.
- Provide for efficient replacements of parts due to standard yearly churn.
- Eliminate parts that are prone to rust, discolouration and fading.

#### Street Sign Recommendations

- Proceed with a consistent sign form that is appropriate throughout Toronto.
- Create a clear message hierarchy that emphasizes St. Name legibility.
- Consistently present street names in reflective white lettering on blue backgrounds for maximum legibility.
- Utilize modular components enabling the addition or replacement of District/BIA branding.



#### Street Sign Recommendations con't

- Integrate coordinated hardware for mounting street signs that upgrades the overall image of Toronto St. Signs.
- Develop extruded components to reduce both production costs and installation costs through modes of mass production.
