Construction Warranty Work on Nugget Avenue from McCowan Road to Shorting Road


Contract: 13SC-05RD Start Date: May 15, 2017 End Date: June 15, 2017 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will complete repairs to sections of curb and sidewalk at various locations on Nugget Avenue from McCowan Road to Shorting Road.

The City's contractor is completing this work as part of the warranty of the work that was completed in 2014. There is no cost associated with this work.

We recognize that construction is disruptive to a community. It is our aim to carry out the work with the least amount of inconvenience to area residents and businesses, and to complete the work as efficiently as possible. Your co-operation and patience is appreciated.

For the warranty work being completed the City's contractor will:

- Dig up the cracked sidewalk and curbs.
- Re-adjust valves.
- · Repair curbs, gutters and driveways
- Complete other works that may be deficient

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Working Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Some of these efforts include adding Local Access signs, revising traffic signal times. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

Traffic on Nugget Avenue will be reduced to one lane at times as required.



Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at **416-808-2222**.



Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. *Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.*



Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.
