Watermain Replacement on Heath Street West and Tichester Road from Bathurst Street to Spadina Road

Contract: 15ECS-LU-30SU

Start Date: June 18, 2017

End Date: June 19, 2017

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto will complete the final asphalt restoration portion of work on the road at the intersection of Tichester Road and Bathurst starting Sunday June 18, 2017.

This will take place overnight, due to the required lane closures on Bathurst.

While the contractor will do their best to work quietly and efficiently, there will be machinery required to complete the work.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2015 Capital Works Program that will improve water distribution and the City's aging infrastructure while reducing the risk of watermain breaks.

- Decommissioned the old watermain

The contractor will now:

- Resurface the intersection of Tichester and Bathurst

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Work Hours: Night Work will take place overnight from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p> <p>Accommodation: Residents that require accommodation must contact the Field Ambassador to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Heath Street West and Tichester Road will be reduced to one lane. Traffic on Bathurst will be reduced to one lane in each direction.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. Please contact parking control for the location of your vehicle at 416-808-2222.</p> <p>Please contact the Field Ambassador listed below if you have questions.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
