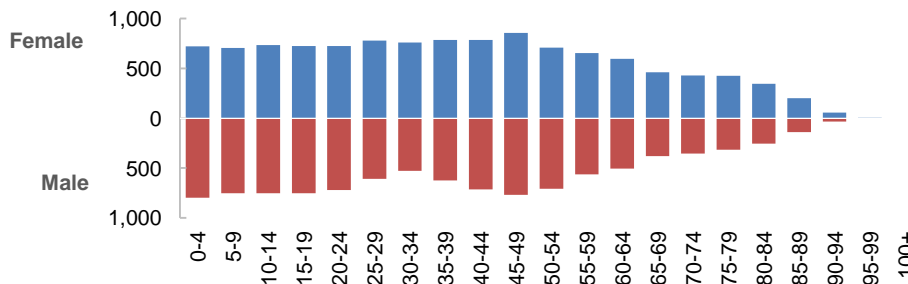

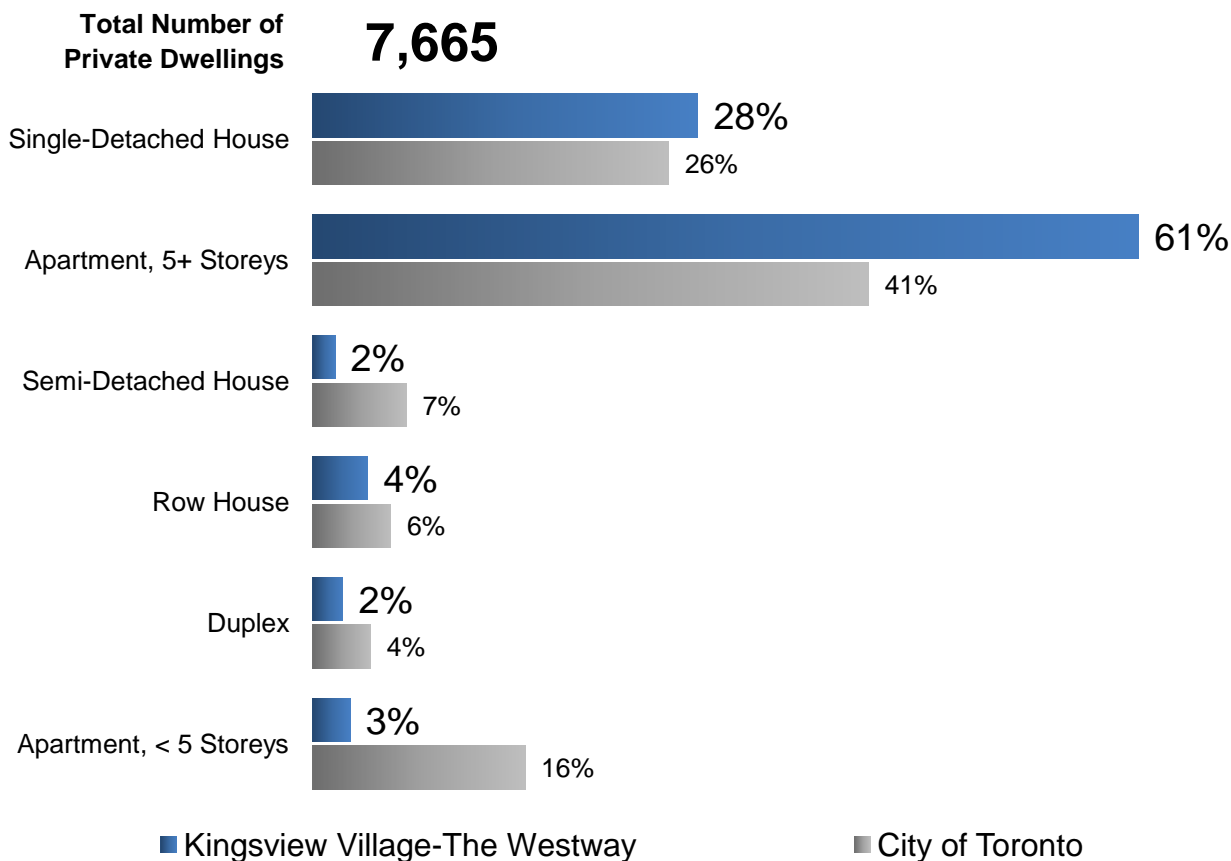

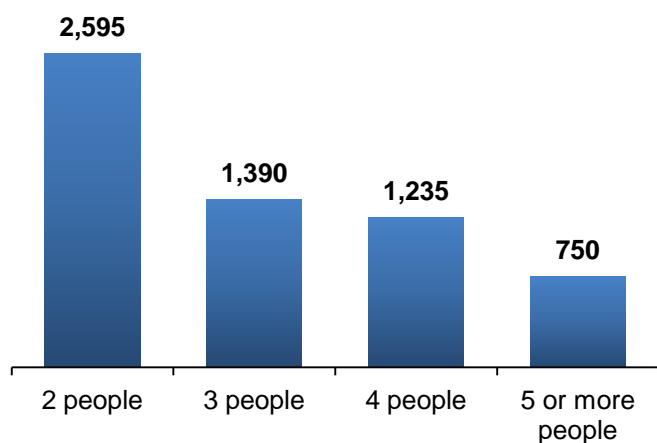

### Number of Census Families by Size of Family



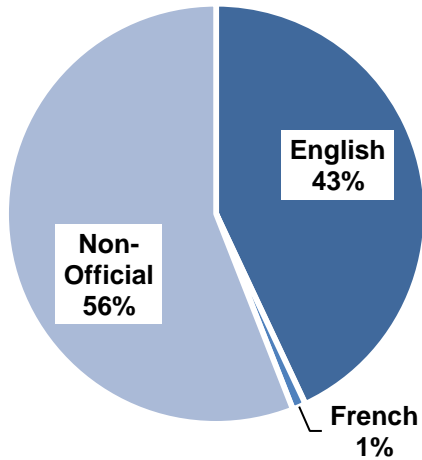

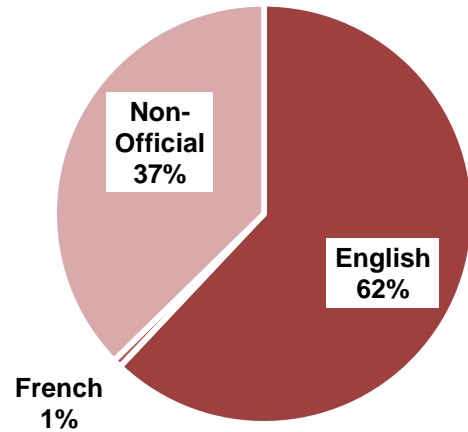

**Mother Tongue (Single-Response)**



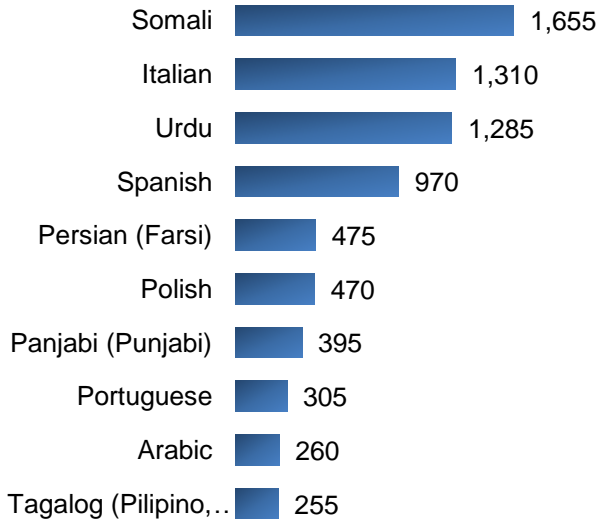

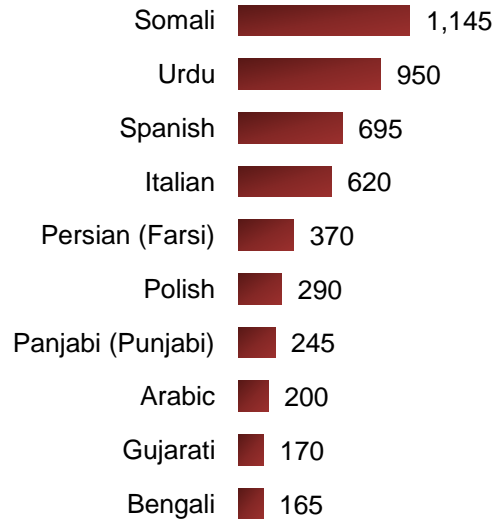

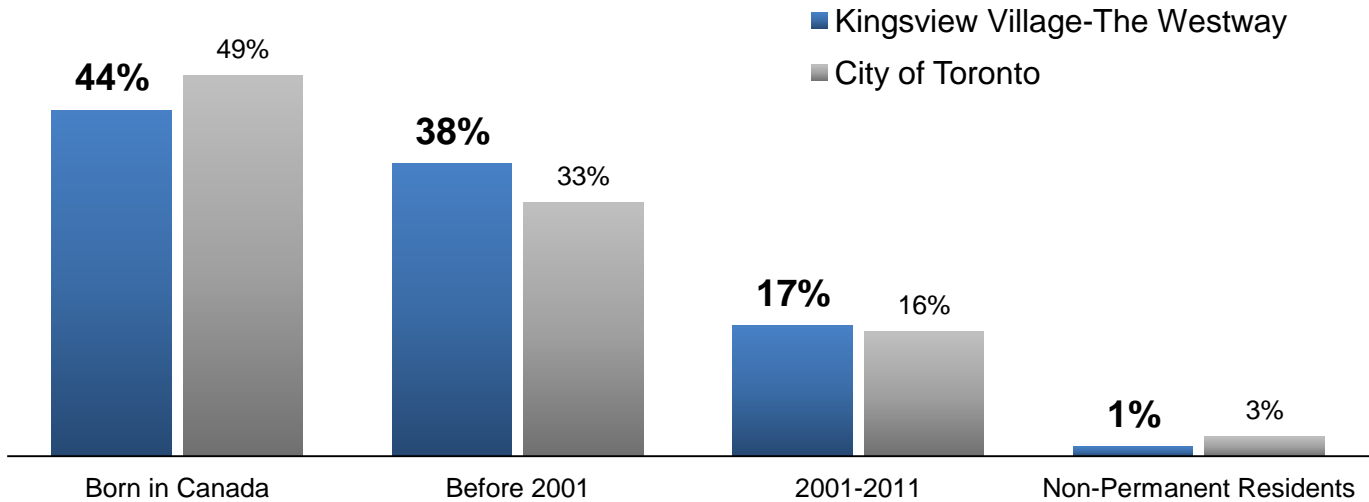

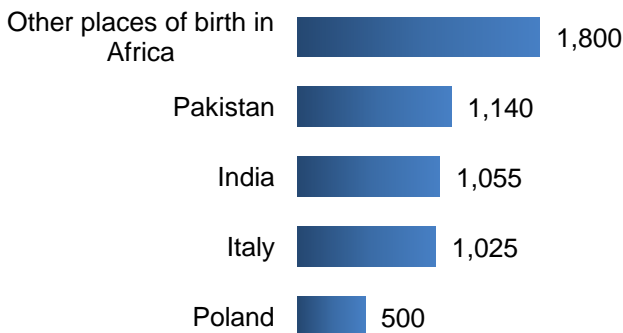

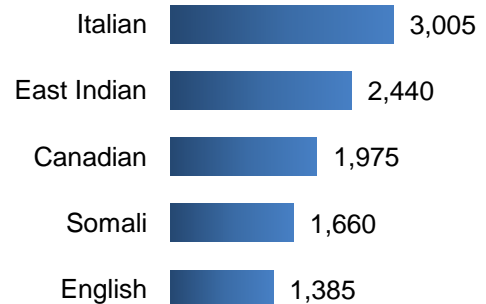
### Period of Immigration



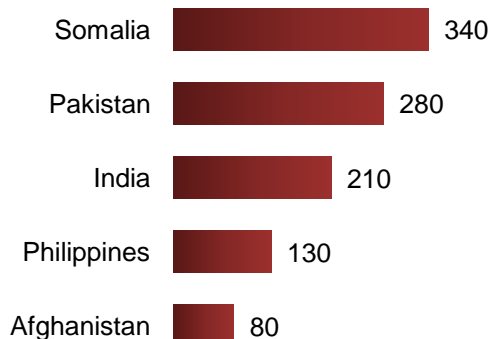
### Top-5 Birth Country for All Immigrants



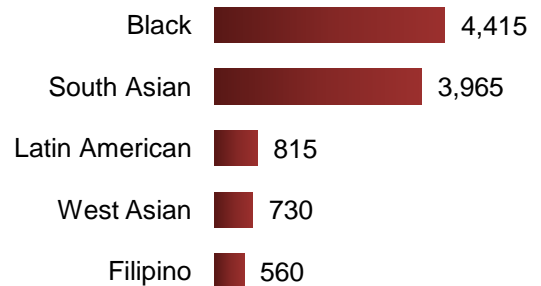
### Top-5 Ethnic Origins

### Top-5 Visible Minority Group

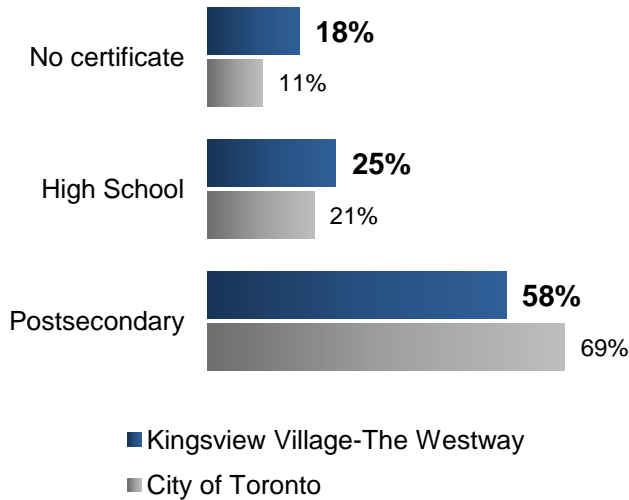

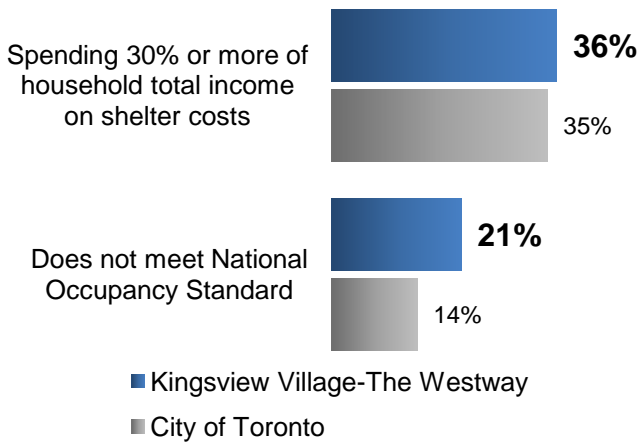
### Highest Educational Attainment for Pop Age 25-64 Yrs

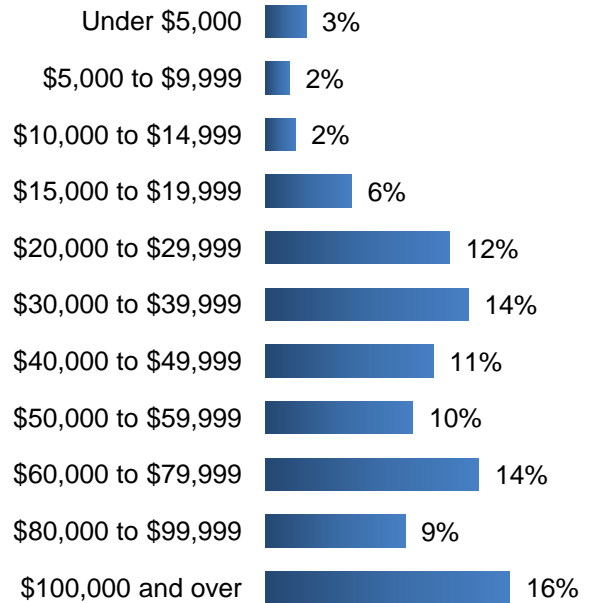
