## Watermain Replacement on Bathurst Street and Eireann Quay

**Contract:** 16ECS-LU-03SU  
**Start Date:** September 6, 2016  
**Expected End Date:** April 30, 2017\*  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Eireann Quay and on Bathurst from Lakeshore Boulevard to Queens Quay continues.

We appreciate your patience while we continue to work on watermain replacement.

### WORK DETAILS

**To date, the following work has been completed:**

- The watermain has been installed on Eireann Quay, up to the Queens Quay intersection
- The watermain has been installed on Bathurst Street, up to the Queens Quay intersection
- Both watermains have passed disinfection testing





**The following work will be completed in the coming weeks:**

- The contractor will connect the newly installed watermain to the existing watermain.
- Each connection will take approximately one night, and then it will be tested to confirm the connection meets MOE water quality requirements.
- While testing is taking place, there will be little to no construction activity on site.
- Once the new main is connected to the water system, water services to properties will be transferred to the new main

**Work scheduled for the spring:**

- Crews will complete sidewalk repairs and restore affected sections of the road.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Most work will take place from <b>10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday night to Friday night</b> with some work during the day on weekends as required (9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.).</p> <p>Overnight work allows the road to remain open and free of work during the day and reduces the interruption to TTC Streetcar service in the community.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p><b>As a part of this work, southbound lanes on Bathurst will typically be closed from Lake Shore Boulevard West to Queens Quay, from 10:00pm to 6:00 am, Monday night to Friday night.</b></p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at <b>416-808-2222</b>.</p>
