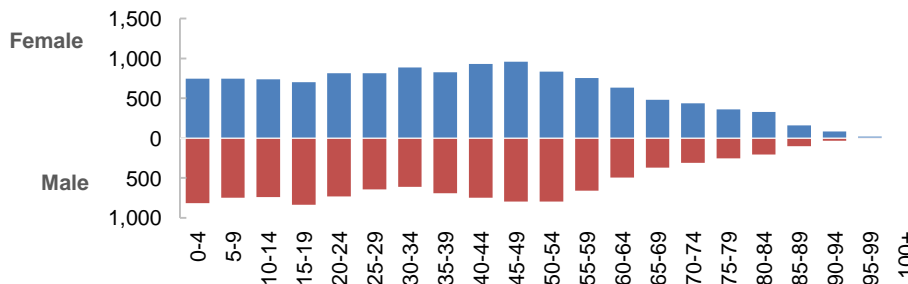

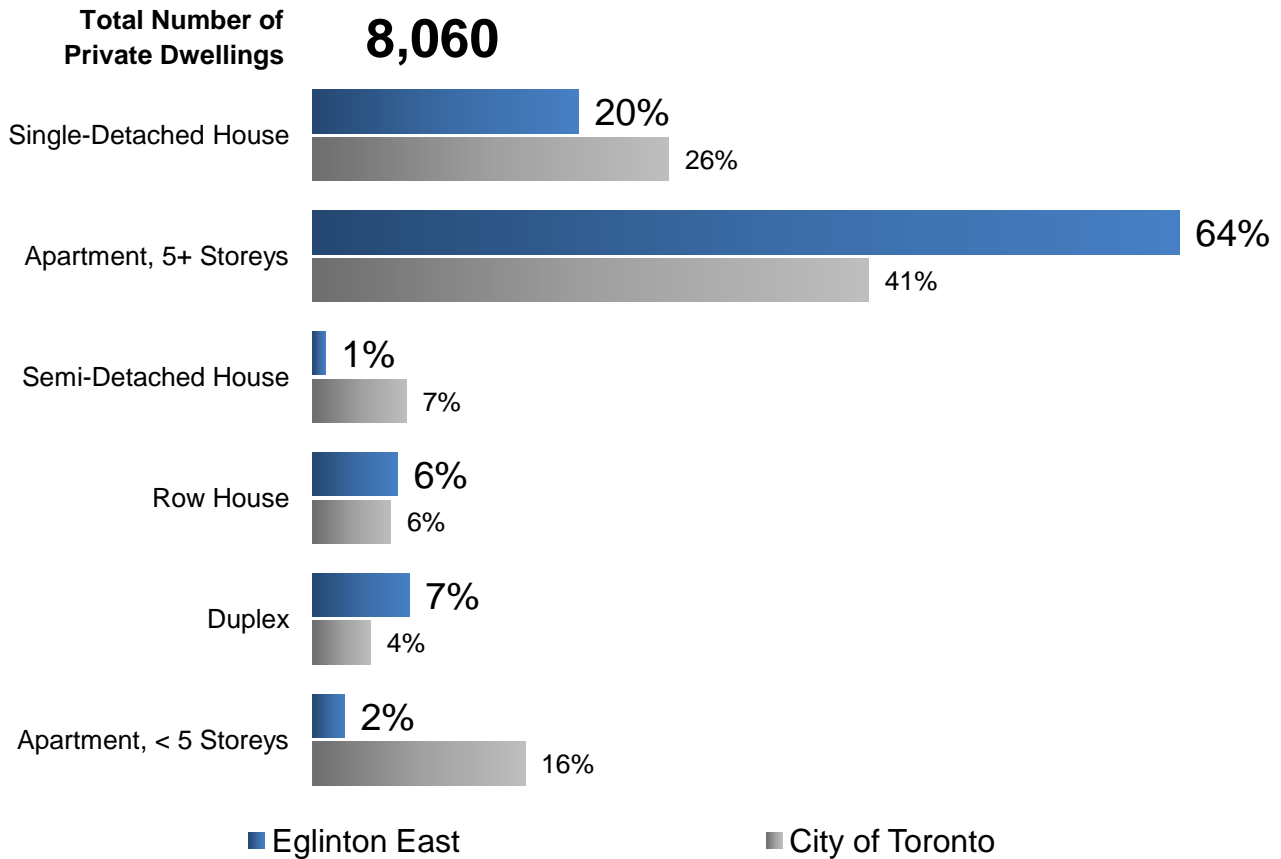

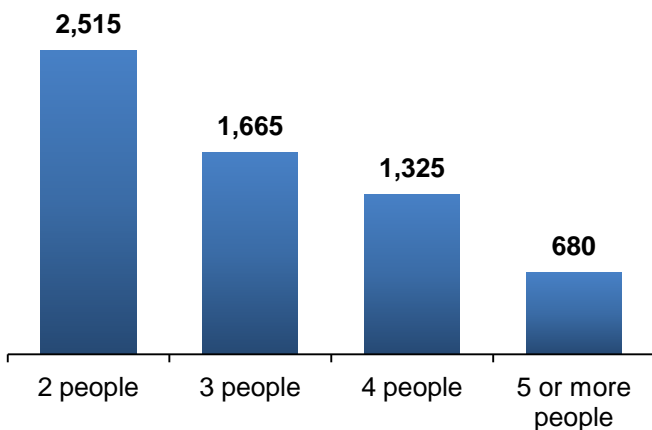

Number of Census Families by Size of Family



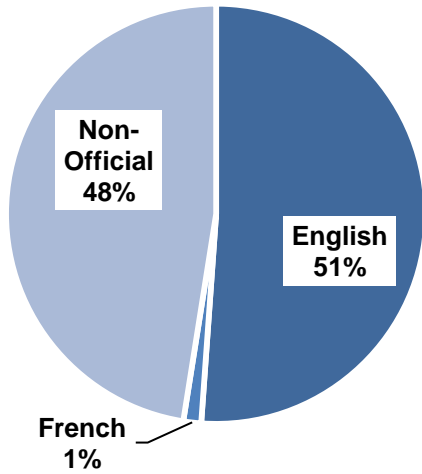

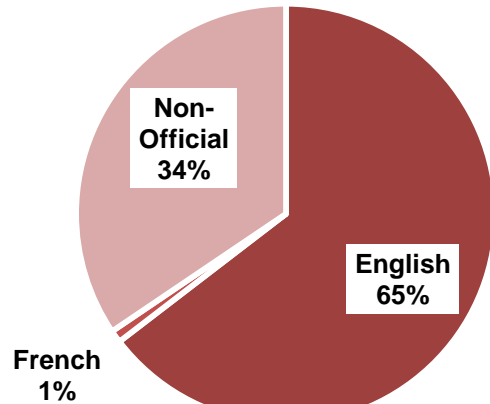

Mother Tongue (Single-Response)



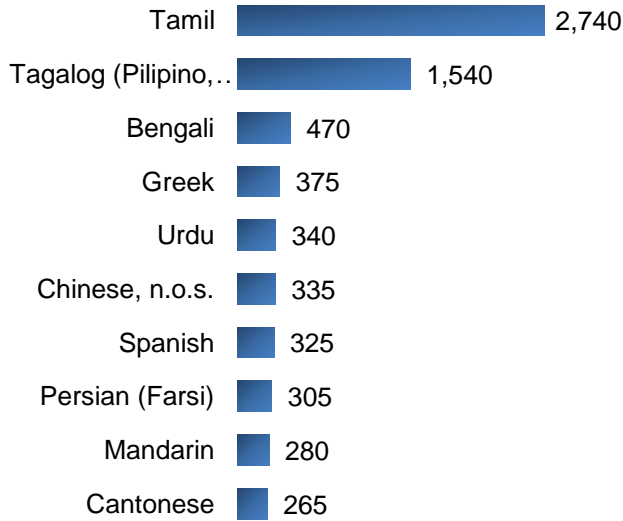

Home Language (Single-Response)

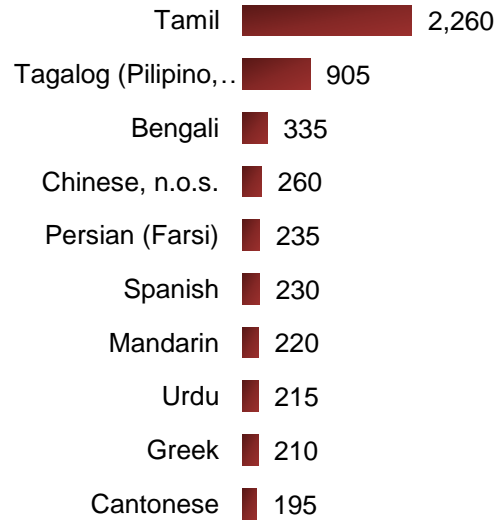

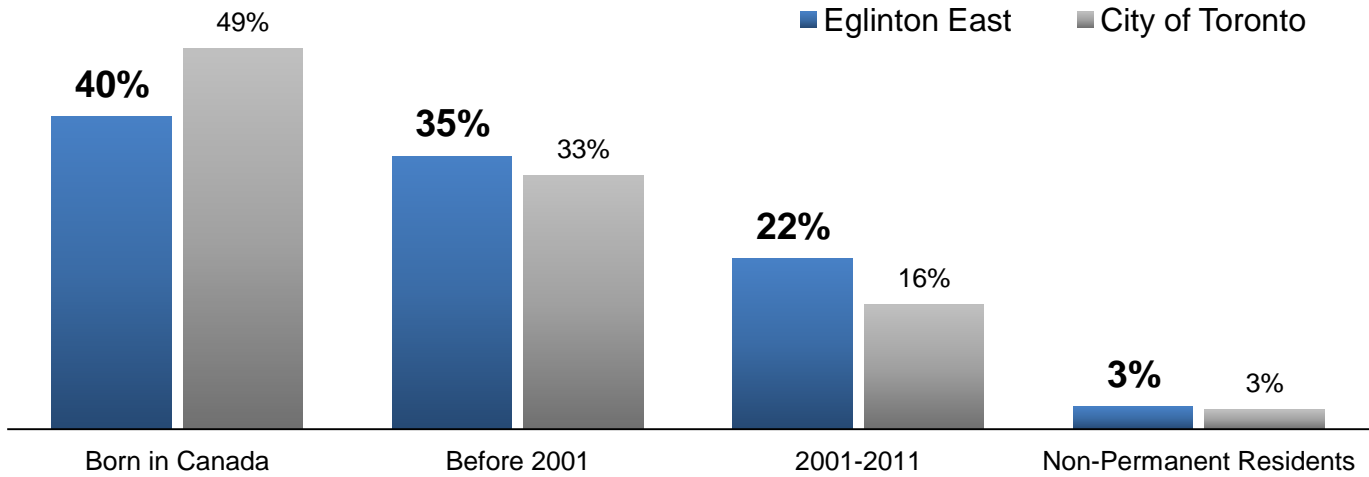

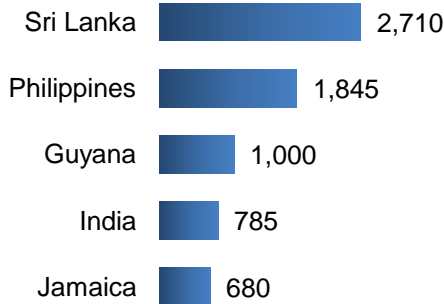

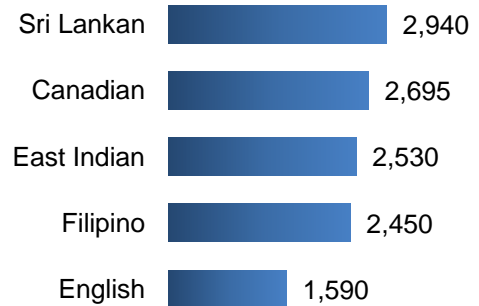
Period of Immigration



Top-5 Birth Country for All Immigrants



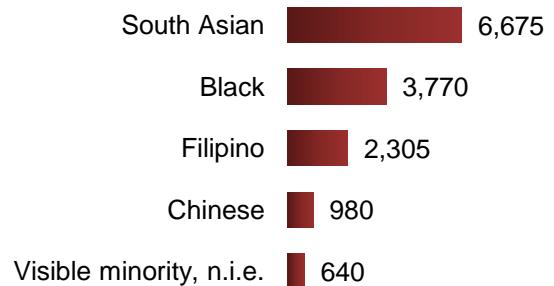
Top-5 Ethnic Origins

Top-5 Visible Minority Group

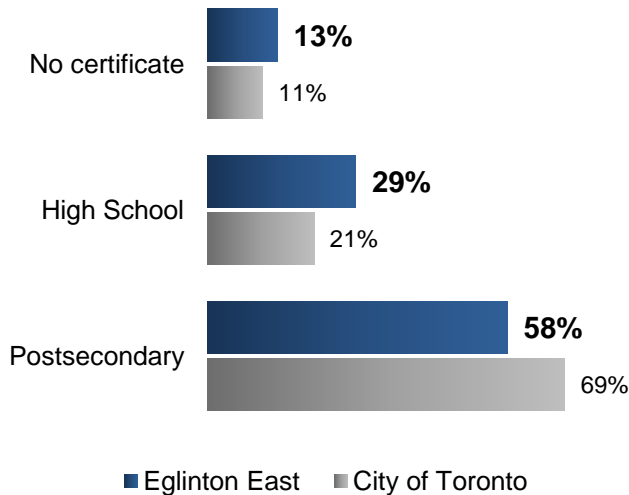

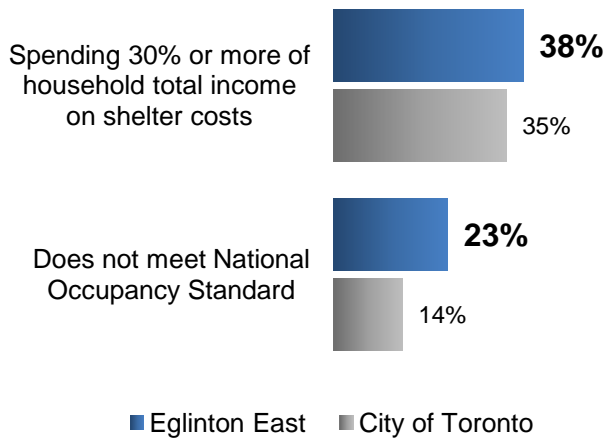
Highest Educational Attainment for Pop Age 25-64 Yrs

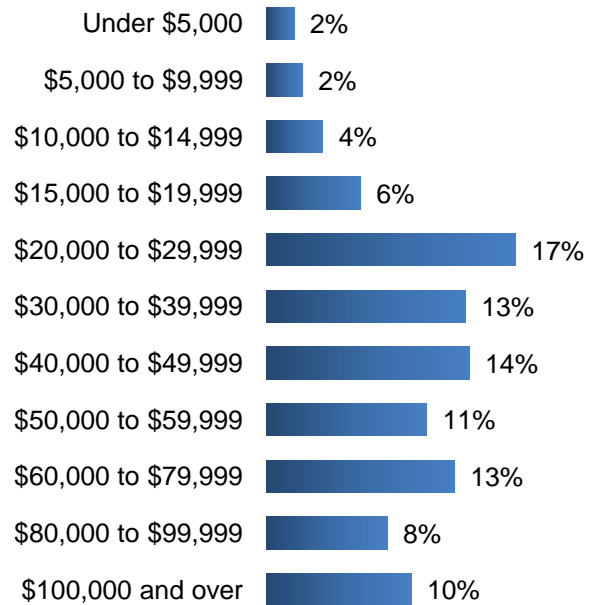
