#### How will I be notified of an emergency?

• Radio • Television • Automated Telephone Call (Durham Only)

#### What should I do if notified?

GO - inside and turn on your radio or television

**LISTEN** — to the media reports

**FOLLOW** — instructions provided by the Province

### What instructions might I receive?

- Evacuate
- Shelter-in-Place
- Take Potassium Iodide (KI) Pills
- Report to a Reception Centre for Monitoring

#### Remember...

- Stay Calm
- Don't Evacuate unless advised to do so
- Avoid Using the Phone unless reporting a 911 Emergency
