



## Facility Statistics Occupancy Screen

## **Home > Facility Management > Statistics Occupancy**

## **Business Purpose:**

The Facility Management Statistics Occupancy page displays aggregate occupancy statistical data for the Facility. They include new intakes, new admissions, discharges, accepted and rejected referrals to and from other Programs, any stays >= 1 day (for Bed Programs only) and total bed nights for the Facility. The columns represent the various time periods including yesterday, current month to date, same full month last year, previous full month, current quarter to date, same full quarter last year, previous full quarter, current year to date and previous entire year.

On this Screen, for a family Intake, Admission, Discharge, Referral and Stay is counted as 1 occurrence regardless of the number of family members present at the time of the action. The only exception is the Bed Nights row, for which each family member contributes to the count.

All stats are as of the official SMIS 4:00 a.m. threshold time. Therefore, yesterday's stats were/are taken as of 4:00 a.m. today.
