## What are community services and facilities (CS&F)?

• Community facilities are non-profit, publicly accessible facilities and places such as libraries, child care and recreation centres where City divisions, school boards and community agencies deliver their programs and services.

## We are studying the community services and facilities in the area:

- to review the services and facilities currently serving the area and the particular needs of the community; and
- to determine what services and facilities are needed to support a growing population.





## COMMUNITY SERVICES & FACILITIES

### Statistics in the Community Services and Facilities (CS&F) Study Area

#### Demographics

- Just under 26,000 people live in the CSF study area
- Youth and young adults (15-29 years) account for 27% of the population
- Approximately 60%, or 15,665, residents were born outside of Canada
- Nearly 50% of households have more than 3 people living at home and 14% of households have 6 or more people
- Over 72% of families have children and 28% are lone-parent families
- Growing household incomes remain well below Toronto average (\$55,270 vs. \$87,038) with an unemployment rate of 11.5%


Libraries - York Woods District Library hosted 1,275 programs in 2016




# COMMUNITY SERVICES & FACILITIES
