Dog Park Temporary Closure St. Clair Reservoir at Sir Winston Churchill Park

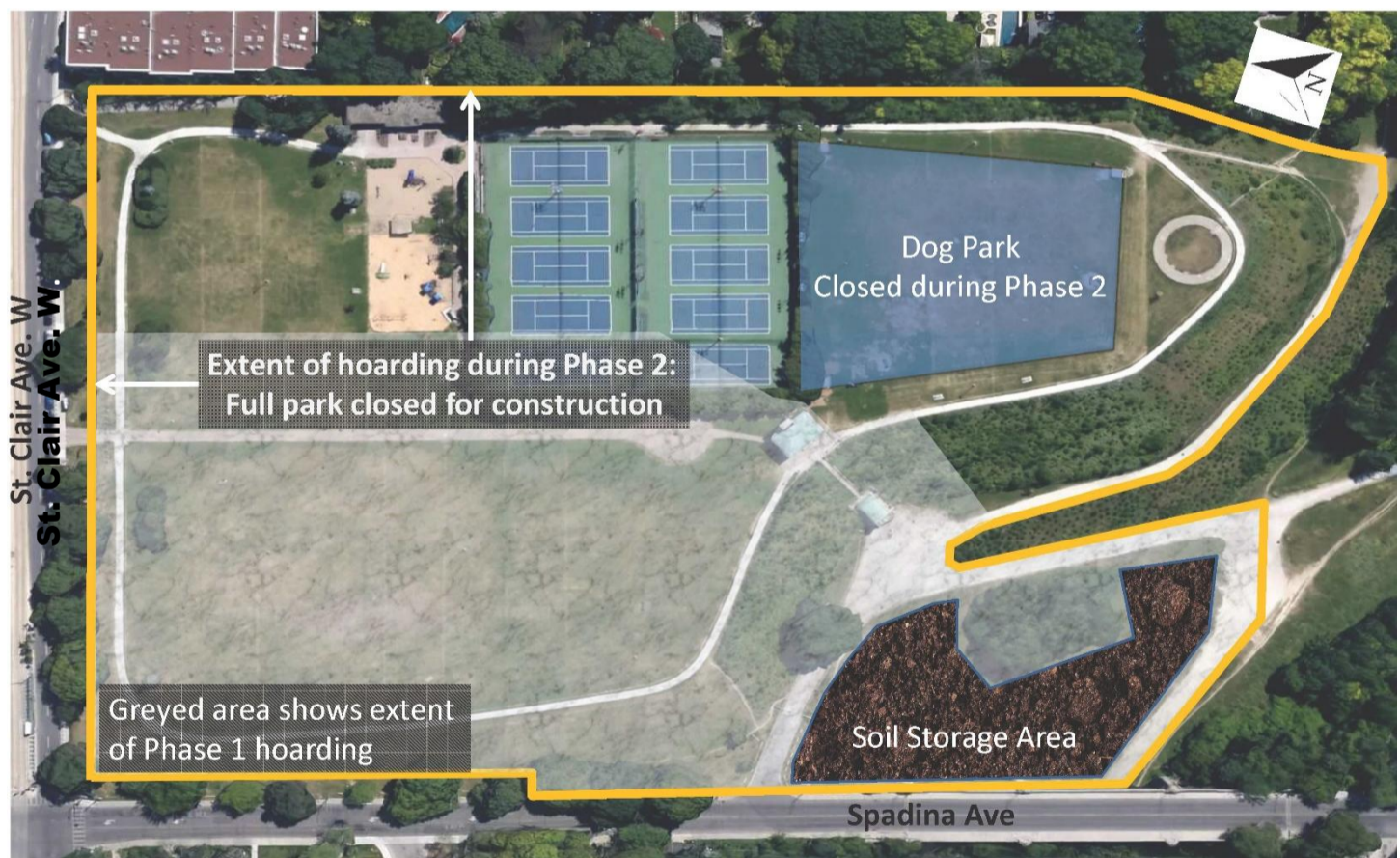

The City of Toronto is carrying out waterproofing and structural rehabilitation work on the St. Clair Reservoir, which is located beneath Sir Winston Churchill Park. The reservoir was originally constructed in 1930 and provides storage of drinking water and fire protection for local residents. This work will improve the aging infrastructure and ensure continued, uninterrupted production of water for years to come. This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 and 2017-2025 Capital Works Program.

During Phase 2 of the construction process, the dog park will be closed. It is anticipated that this closure will be in place from Spring 2017 to Fall 2019. Please note the timeline is subject to change. The dog park will be reinstated upon completion of the project.

Please be aware that the City will be turning off (winterizing) the water fountain within the dog park in fall 2016 as part of routine, annual maintenance.
