

ELIZABETH 'BETTY' COULTER

1918 - 2003

Elizabeth "Betty" Coulter enhanced the lives of Etobicoke residents through her contributions to her church and community. For over seventeen years, she wrote *Church News* and *Sky Light*, two popular columns with the Etobicoke Guardian newspaper.

Coulter was also acknowledged as a guiding light behind *The Spires*, a publication founded in 1975, which ran for

over two decades, promoting family and community values in Etobicoke. Additionally, she was a regular presence on local television where she hosted a program dealing with a range of community, cultural, and religious themes. Coulter also edited six books.

On the occasion of her induction into the Etobicoke Hall of Fame in 1990, it was noted that "Mrs. Coulter is the type of quiet, behind the scenes volunteer whose warm smile and friendly manner brings joy into the lives of everyone with whom she has contact." Coulter was recognized for her service to her community by promoting many causes that she believed in through her writing and publications.
