# Sanitary Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation on Lawrence Avenue East and Beechgrove Drive From Atkinson Avenue to Satok Terrace

Contract #: 16ECS-LU-02TT Start Date: June, 2017 Expected End Date: June, 2018 \*Content/dates subject to change.

This notice serves as an update to the work the City is completing to rehabilitate a section of the Highland Creek Sanitary Trunk Sewer (STS) on Lawrence Avenue East and Beechgrove Drive from Atkinson Avenue to Satok Terrace. Work is progressing well.

In order to complete the next section of work, the northbound lane on Beechgrove Drive within the construction zone will be closed. Due to the large size of the construction access Shaft #2, there will only be southbound traffic on Beechgrove Drive will between **November 1, 2017 and November 30, 2017.** Thank you for your patience during this phase of construction.

## WORK DETAILS

To date, the contractor has:

• Installed temporary bypass pipes between the two shafts so sewer flow can be maintained, while repairs are taking place inside the sewer.

The contractor will:

- Continue constructing a deep shaft on top of the sewer at Shaft locations (see map) on Lawrence Avenue E and Beechgrove Drive.
- Repair the sewer when the shafts are complete (this will occur in winter). Using a slip-lining technique where the contractor inserts pipe pieces through shafts and then joins them inside the existing pipe which forms a new pipe inside this sewer section.





## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes is expected. This work includes creating temporary sidewalks which will be put back to its original condition when the work is completed.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager.
- If your driveway access is impacted, the Contractor will arrange temporary parking.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

£	<b>Traffic Management</b> : Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.	
	<ul> <li>Beechgrove Drive will be reduced to a single one-way southbound lane within the construction zone. Northbound traffic on Beechgrove Drive will be diverted to Dunstall Crescent with detour signs.</li> <li>Lawrence Avenue E is reduced to a single lane in both directions within the construction zone.</li> </ul>	
	Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.	
G O	<b>Cyclists:</b> Cyclists travelling on Beechgrove Drive between Lawrence Ave E and Satok Terrace must dismount their bikes within the construction zone and walk with their bicycles on the pedestrian sidewalk at the west of Beechgrove Drive.	
	Work Hours: The contractor will complete most work Monday to Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., with occasional work after hours and on weekend.	
	Overnight work is required during 2 consecutive weeks in winter when the sewer rehabilitation work will occur.	
đ	<b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents / businesses that require accommodation (level entry, wheel trans entry etc.) must contact the <b>Project Manager</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.
