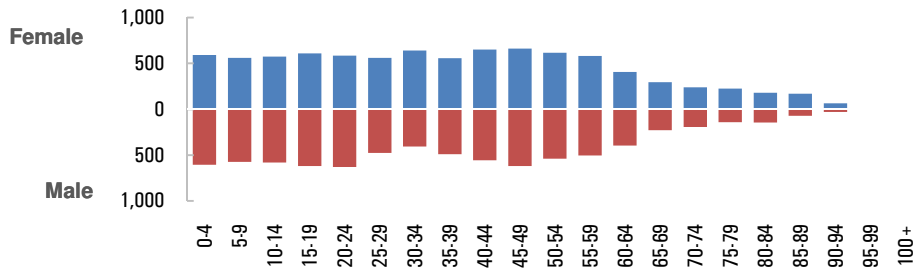

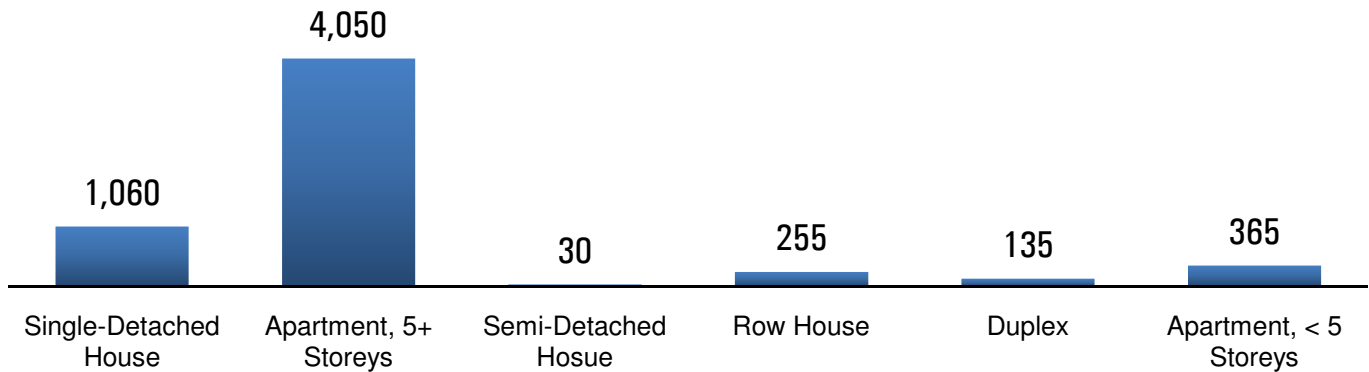

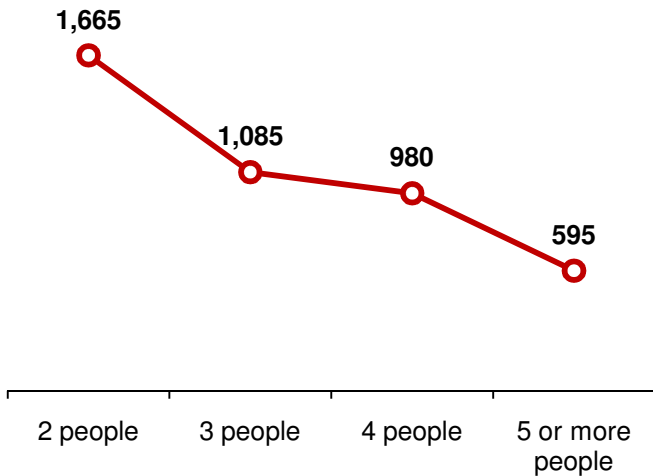

Number of Census Families by Size of Family

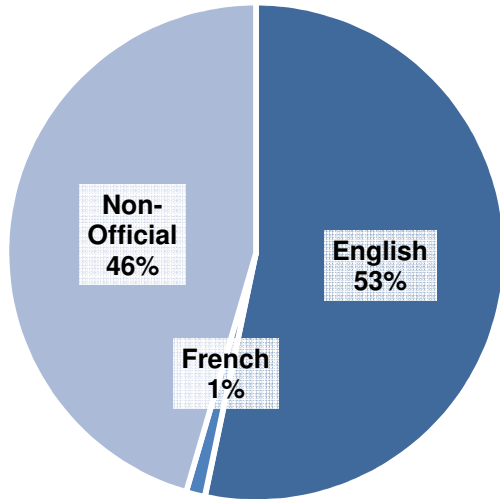

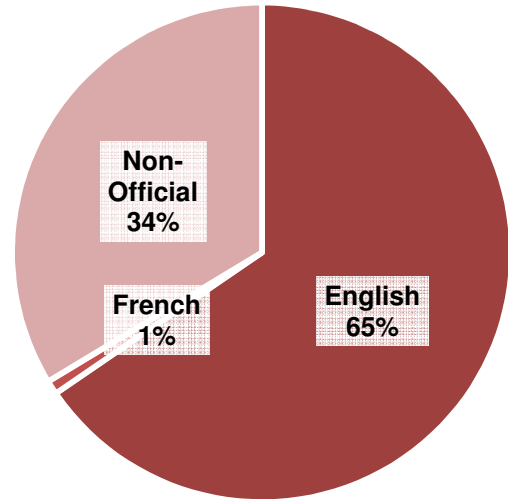

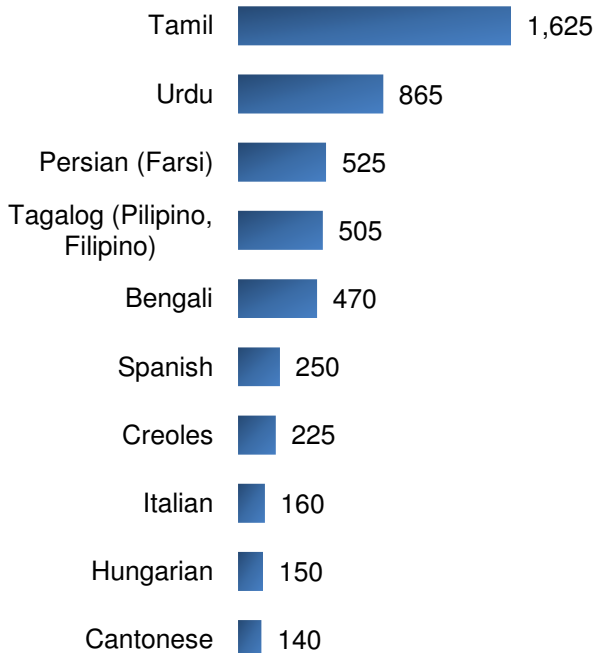
Mother Tongue



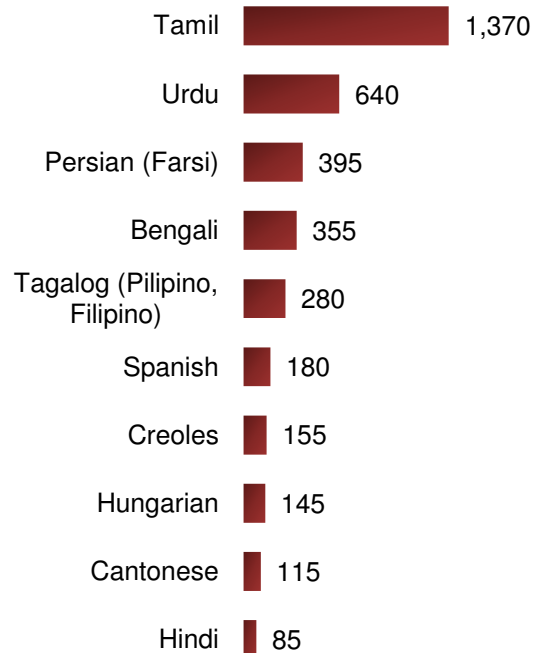
Home Language



Top-10 Non-Official Mother Tongue Languages



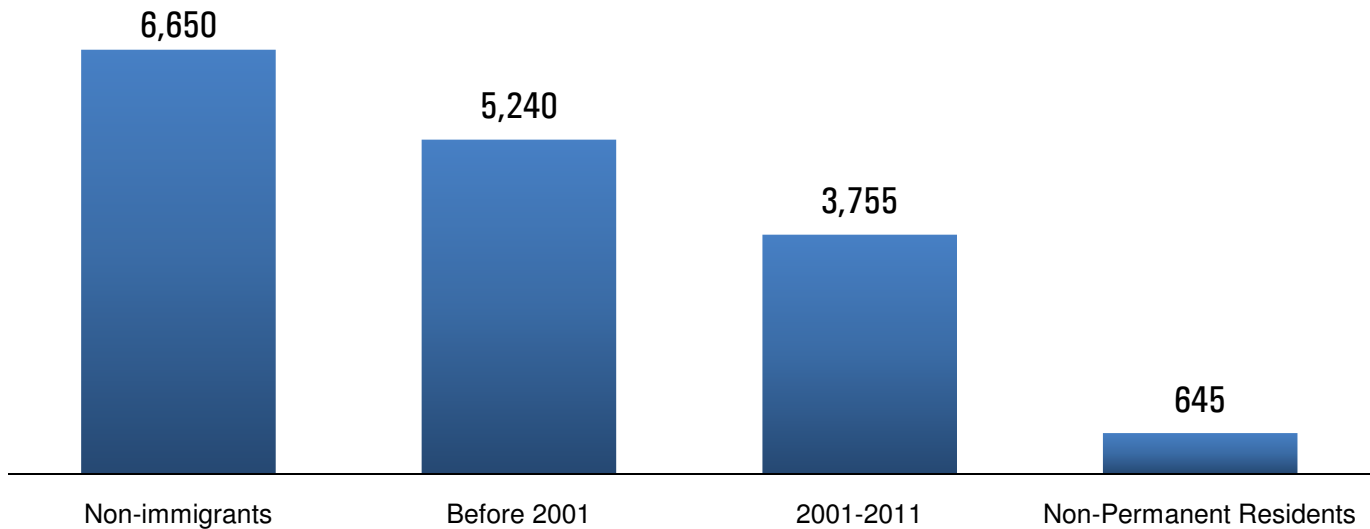
Top-10 Non-Official Home Languages



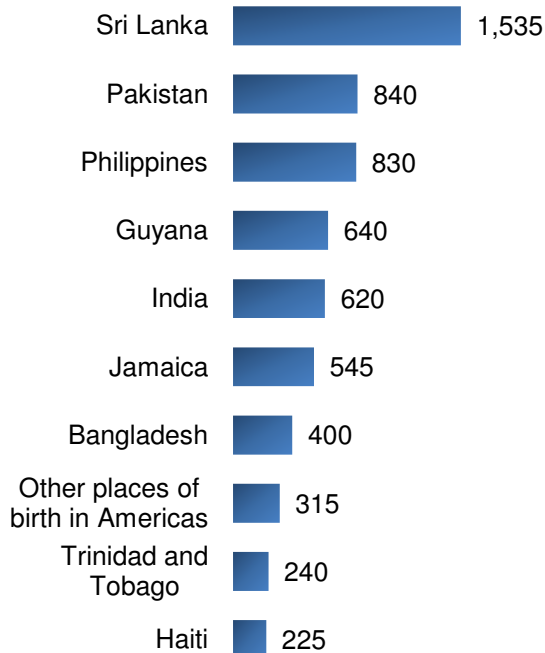

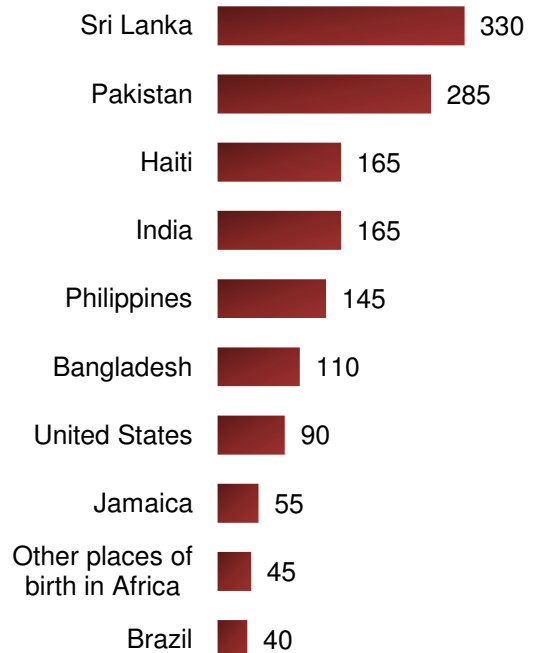
Year Arrived in Canada



Top-10 Birth Country for All Immigrants



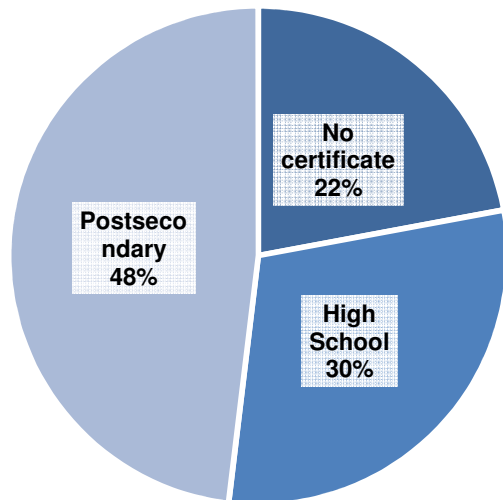
Top-10 Birth Country for Recent Immigrants



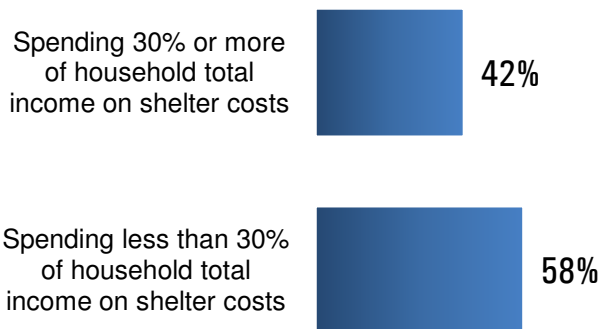

Note on Comparability:

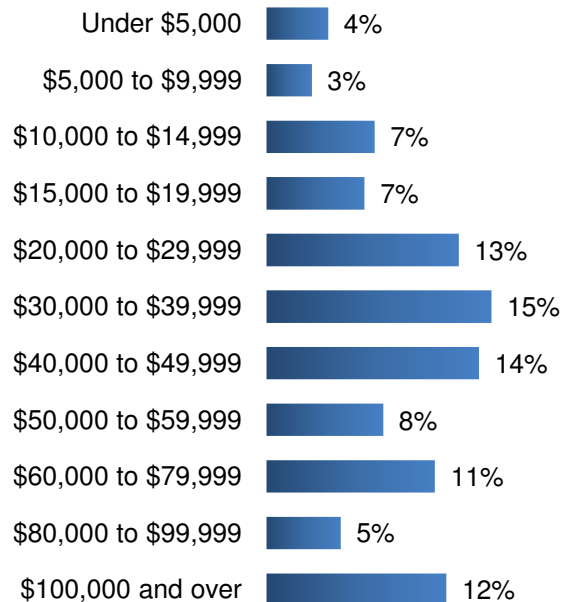
