Basement Flooding Protection Program Sanitary, Storm Sewer & Watermain Replacements in Bestview Park and other local roads

Contract: 16ECS-LU-05FP
Start Date: November 28, 2016
Original End Date: June 30, 2017
NEW End Dates: November 15, 2017

This notice provides an update on the construction activities taking place on Bestview Park, Bestview Drive, Goldenwood Road, Harrington Crescent and Kentland Crescent.

This project was originally scheduled to be completed by the end of June 2017 and subsequently re-scheduled for completion by the end of September 2017. The project has encountered additional, unplanned delays that involved some utilities within the work zone and increasing the planned road work as part of our restoration; we also lost some days to wet weather.

We have secured the updated work schedule that incorporates all remaining work. All road restorations within the Road ROW should be completed by October 30, 2017. Tree planting and restorations within the Bestview Park is expected to be completed by November 15, 2017.

We appreciate your patience and continued understanding during this construction.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

Bestview Park from Storm sewer Outfall in the Ravine to Bestview Drive:

- Storm sewer upgrade completed.

Bestview Drive from Laureleaf Drive to Goldenwood Road:

- Storm sewer upgrade and sewer lateral replacements completed.
- Some remaining sidewalk replacement at the intersections in progress.

Goldenwood Road from Bestview Drive to Sparwood Court:

- Storm sewer upgrade and sewer lateral replacements completed.
- Sidewalk replacement completed.
- Curb and gutter installation completed.

Harrington Crescent from Bestview Drive to Goldenwood Road:

- Storm sewer upgrade and sewer lateral replacements completed.
- Sidewalk replacement completed.
- Curb and gutter installation in progress.

Harrington Crescent from Goldenwood Road to Mintwood Drive:

- Storm sewer upgrade and sewer lateral replacements completed.
- Sidewalk replacement completed.
- Curb and gutter installation in progress.

Kentland Crescent from south of Bestview Drive to Bestview Drive:

- Storm sewer upgrade and sewer lateral replacements completed.
- Curb and gutter installation in progress

Bestview Drive from Laureleaf Drive to Kentland Crescent:

- Storm sewer upgrade and sewer lateral replacements completed.
- Sidewalk replacement in progress.
- Curb and gutter installation in progress.
- Road base paving completed in front of Steelesview Public School.

REMAINING WORK

- Complete all remaining sidewalk and curb & gutter replacements.
- Replace catch basin frame and grates and maintenance hole frame and covers where needed.
- Complete all road paving (base course and top course)
- Complete all restorations, including planting trees and shrubs inside the Bestview Park and the ravine.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You will experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Field Ambassador at **416-507-3492** or **Dave.Brown@stantec.com**
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p>Traffic will be reduced to one lane in work areas.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</p>
	<p>Restoration: Areas affected by construction will be restored.</p>




