

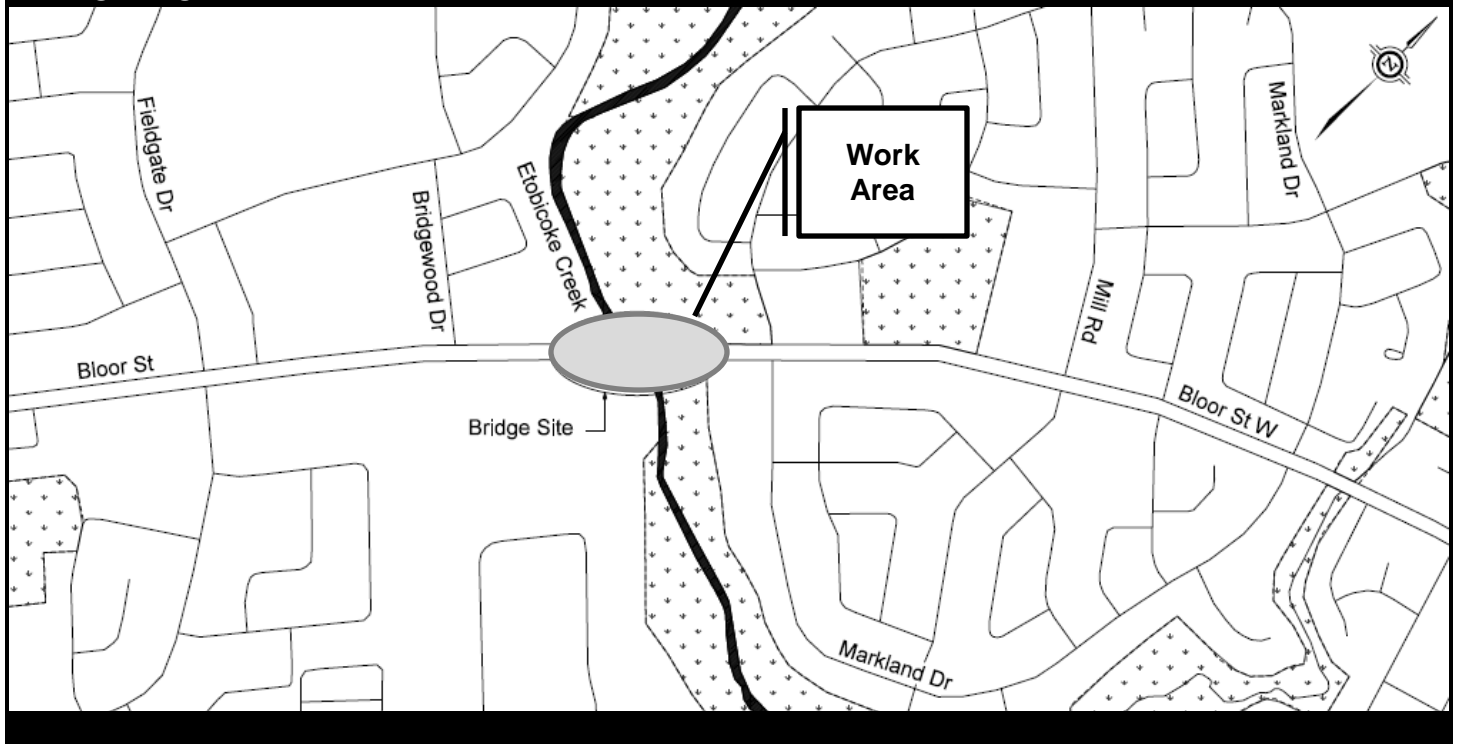

Bloor Street West Bridge Rehabilitation over Etobicoke Creek

Contract: 14ECS-TI-01BE
Expected Start Date: September 2017
Expected End Date: December 2017

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the Bloor Street West Bridge over Etobicoke Creek starting in September 2017. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will repair and refurbish the existing structure at road level and under the bridge and will:

- Remove asphalt, repair concrete deck, waterproof and pave.
- Reconstruct the bridge sidewalks and patch-repair parapet walls.
- Patch-repair bridge soffit, abutments and piers.
- Restore all areas affected by construction.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work area. At least one sidewalk on the bridge will be accessible to pedestrians throughout the construction period.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>The work on the bridge deck will require lane closures with one lane open in each direction.</p>
	<p>Transit Service: This project will affect travel times of Mississauga Transit Routes that travel along Bloor Street. The TTC's Bloor Street route to the east of the bridge location (at Markland Dr.) may also be affected.</p> <p>Visit ttc.ca or mississauga.ca/portal/miway for accurate schedule information.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks or other similar features that are removed during construction will be replaced if impacted by construction.</p>
