@ Park Lawn Road / Marine Parade Drive

Streetcar Track Replacement on Lake Shore Blvd West

Closure Start Date: 10AM Friday, October 6, 2017 Closure End Date: 6AM Tuesday, October 10, 2017

*Timeline is subject to change.

The City contractor's work on Lake Shore Boulevard West continues. In order to safely remove and replace the track allowance on a section of the street, the intersection of Lake Shore Blvd West at Park Lawn Road / Marine Parade Drive will be partially closed for track replacement.

This work will take place from 10AM Friday, October 6 to 6AM Tuesday, October 10, 2017.

Further updates regarding the remaining work will be delivered in the coming weeks.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



This intersection work will take place 24/7.

- The loudest portion of work is on the first day when breaking and removing concrete. This type of work will stop at 11:00 p.m.
- The work hours will be split between the City's contractor and TTC staff working on the track replacement.
- Other work will take place over night. The overnight rail work by TTC may consist of moving new rail into position, rail installation and rail welding / grinding and concrete pouring/curing. Afterhours work by TTC is required to support the daytime construction and complete work more efficiently.

Regular work hours on this project will resume on October 10, 2017.



Traffic Management:

- Eastbound and Westbound traffic on Lake Shore Blvd West will be maintained in the curb lanes through the intersection.
- Southbound traffic on Park Lawn can turn right onto Westbound Lake Shore Blvd West only with no left turns permitted to Eastbound Lake Shore Blvd West.
- Northbound traffic on Marine Parade Drive can turn right onto Eastbound Lake Shore Blvd West only with no left turns permitted to Westbound Lake Shore Blvd
- Drivers can access Westbound Lake Shore Blvd West using Silver Moon Drive. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.



TTC Service:

The eastbound and westbound transit stops on Lake Shore Blvd West at Park Lawn Road / Marine Parade Drive will be temporarily relocated nearby, and reinstated soon after the work zone is cleared.

- 501L/301 Queen buses will be maintained along regular routing.
- 501M Queen shuttle buses will NOT operate on Marine Parade Drive and on Park Lawn Road during the Lake Shore/Park Lawn intersection track work. Shuttle buses will operate a clockwise service linking The Queensway with Lake Shore Boulevard West, via: south on Windermere, west on Lake Shore, west on Mimico, north on Royal York and east on The Queensway and back to Windermere.
- 66B Prince Edward buses will operate south on Park Lawn, east on Queensway, south on Windermere, west on Lake Shore, west on Mimico, north on Royal York and east on Queensway to route (to Old Mill Station) - no service on Marine
- 145 Downtown/Humber Bay Express buses will operate on Lake Shore Boulevard West and will not operate on Marine Parade Drive during the partial intersection

Pedestrian Access: Both east-west crosswalks for pedestrian crossing on Lake Shore Blvd. West will be closed until 6AM Tuesday, October 10, 2017. Pedestrians will have to cross at the closest crosswalk either to the east or west of the Park Lawn Road / Marine Parade Drive and Lake Shore Blvd. West intersection.

The north and south crosswalks across Park Lawn Road and Marine Drive will remain open during this partial intersection closure.




Accommodation: Residents that require accommodation must contact the Project Information Line to arrange for access during construction.
