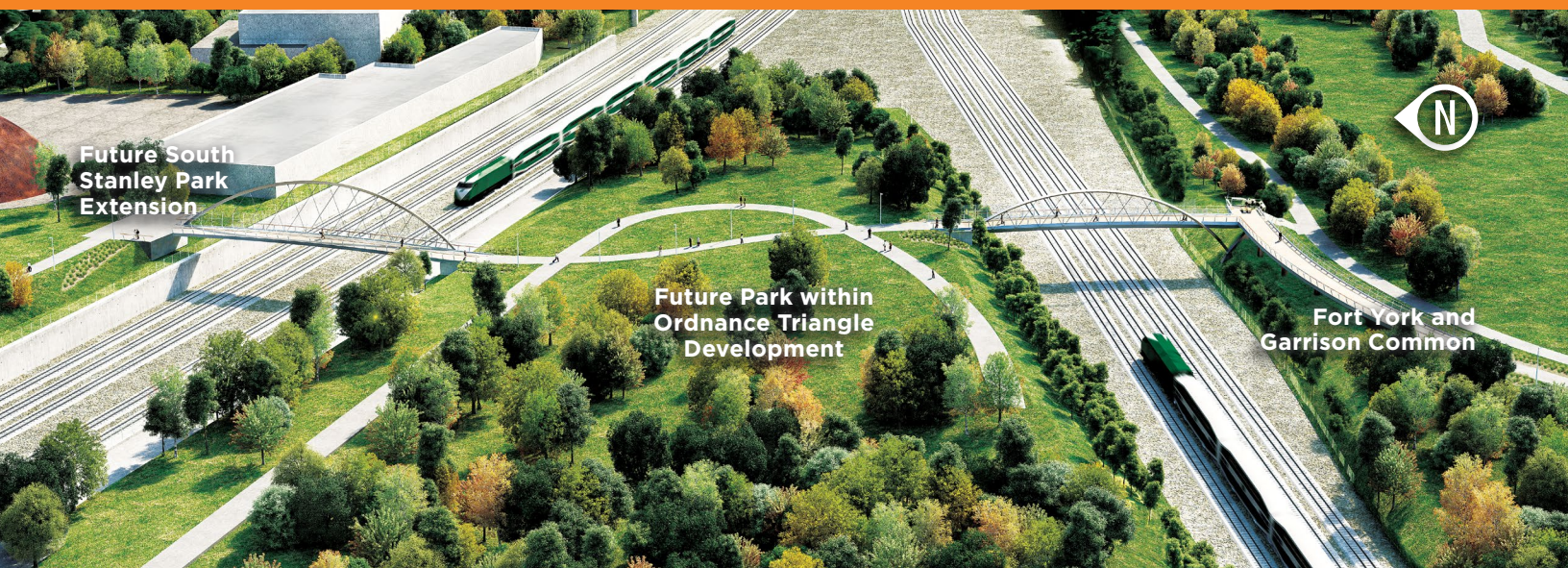

CONSTRUCTION OF THE FORT YORK PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE BRIDGE IS NOW UNDERWAY. NEW PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE PATHWAY COMING TO THIS NEIGHBOURHOOD!

The new bridge will connect the surrounding park system and communities with Fort York and the waterfront.

As a result of this work there may be noise, dust and temporary inconveniences in and around the work sites. We appreciate your patience as we undertake this important city building project.

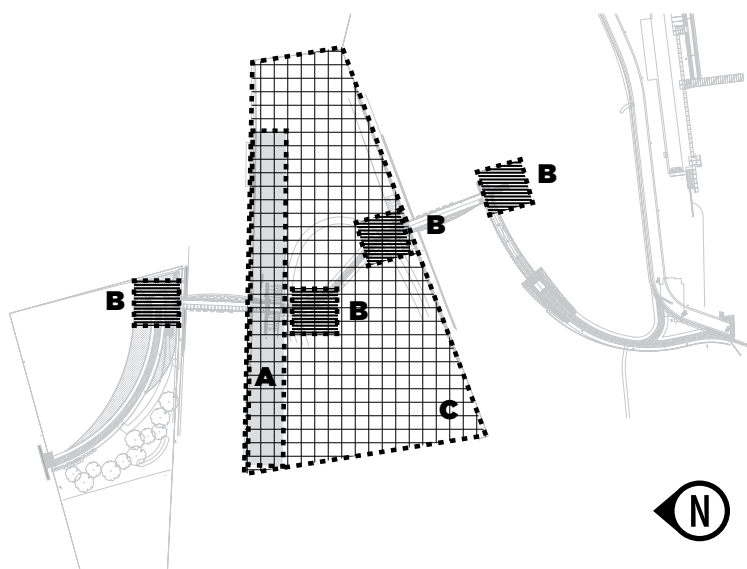
WORK ON THE FORT YORK PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE BRIDGE WILL OCCUR IN 3 PHASES:

PHASE 1: AUGUST - OCTOBER 2016

- A** Construct a retaining wall in Ordnance Park
- B** Construct bridge supports in Ordnance Park, Garrison Common and South Stanley Park Extension
- C** Place fill in Ordnance Park to facilitate grading (work completed as part of Ordnance development)

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Construction activities will take place during the day (7am to 7pm).
- This includes installation of foundation piles, which we can expect to produce a fair amount of noise and minimal dust.



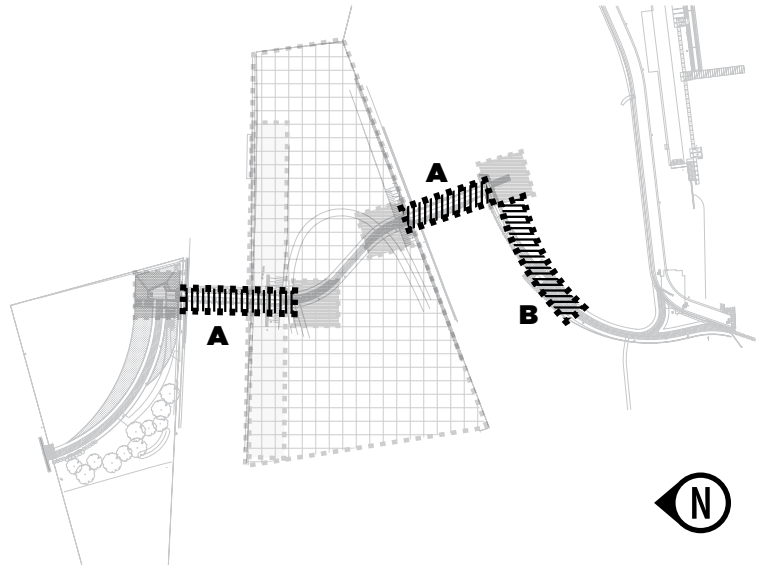
CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

PHASE 2: APRIL - JULY 2017

- A** Steel assembly, installation of bridge structures and pouring of bridge decks
- B** Complete ramp into Garrison Common

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Construction activities will take place during the day (7am to 7pm), with some work being done at night (7pm to 7am).
- The preparation for and installation of the bridge structures will be completed at night (7pm to 7am).
- There will be minimal impact to pedestrian access to the Fort York grounds during the ramp construction into Garrison Common.

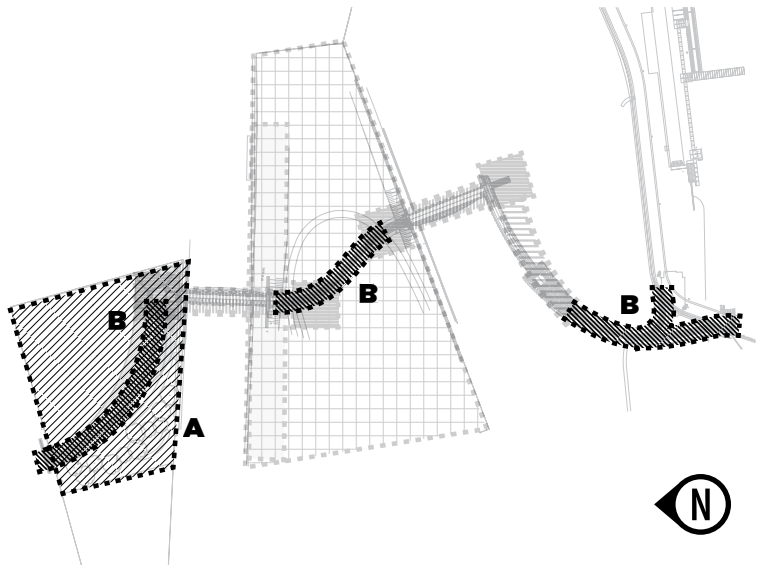


PHASE 3: AUGUST - SEPTEMBER 2017

- A** Place fill and complete South Stanley Park Extension to base park condition
- B** Complete trail paths

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Construction activities will take place during the day (7am to 7pm).
- No significant disturbances expected.
