Glen Cedar Road Bridge Rehabilitation over Cedarvale Ravine

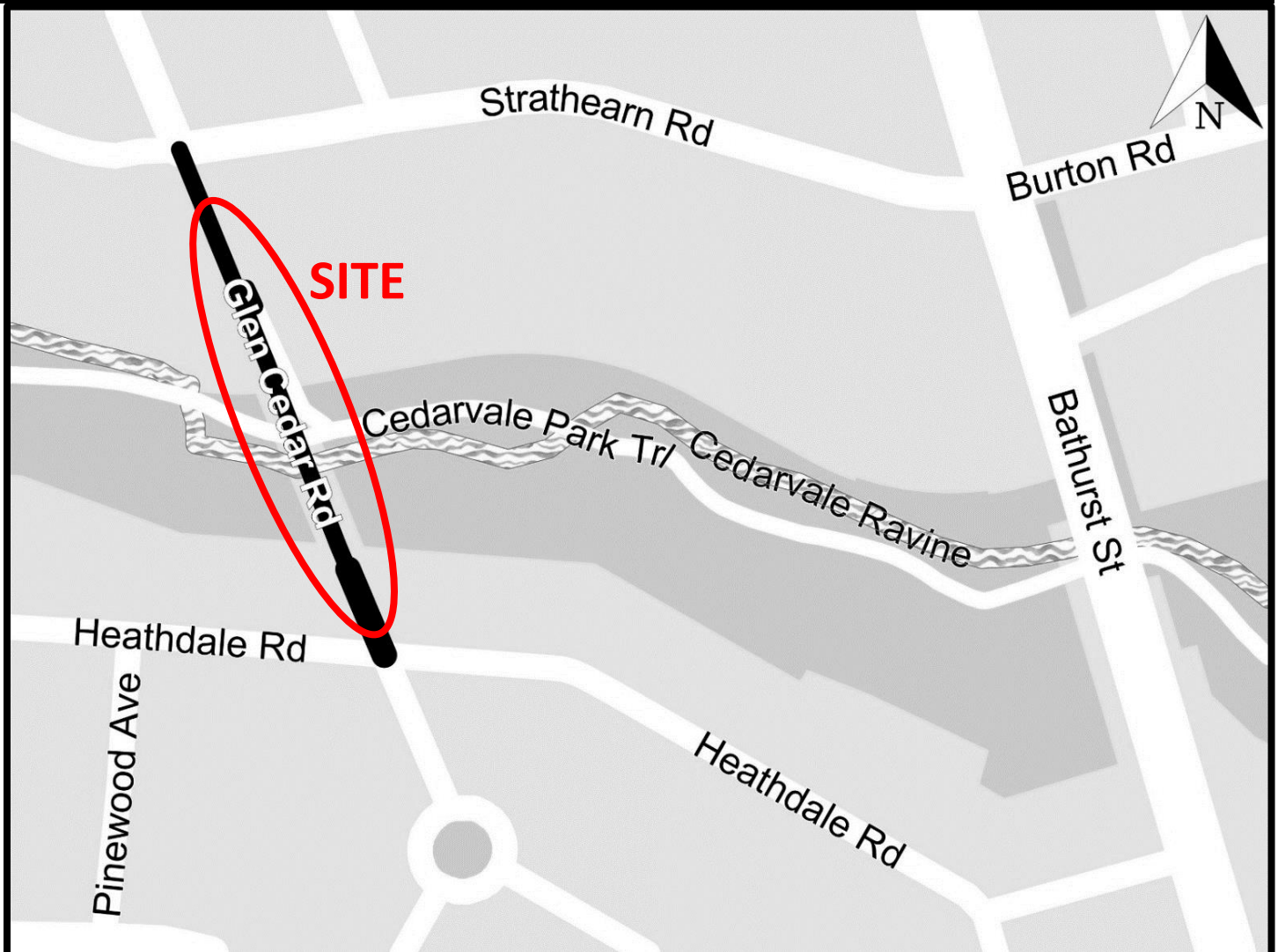
Expected Start Date: Fall 2017

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Glen Cedar Road Bridge over Cedarvale Ravine and the adjacent staircase. This work will ensure that the bridge and staircase meets today's standards and remains safe for pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark walkways and grassed areas with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, clear sidewalk path etc.) must contact the Project Manager to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p>Bridge and Stairs Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be access restrictions along sections of the bridge and to the stairs connecting to the trail within the construction work area. Please note that pedestrian access across the bridge will be maintained when possible. Further details on the restrictions and staging will be provided in the Construction Notice.</p>
