

The City of Toronto will be improving the intersection at Indian Road and High Park Blvd to improve Pedestrian Safety at this intersection by raising the elevation of the intersection to reduce the driving speed, adding zebra cross lines and tactile plates at the curb corners.

The work is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program to renew aging city roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected streets will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p>Pre-Construction Inspection: An inspection company under contract to the City of Toronto, will survey all properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Participation in the survey is voluntary; however, participating is important in determining if the construction caused damage. The inspection will look at both the interior and exterior of all properties to verify existing conditions. The company will deliver a separate notice requesting time to set up appointments. All inspection staff will be wearing photo identification and carrying photographic equipment during their work.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the Project Engineer to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
