## Bathurst Street: Lake Shore Blvd W to Queens Quay W Permanent Restoration of the Watermain Trench in the Roadway and Sidewalk

**Contract: 16ECS-LU-03SU**  
**Start Date: September 6, 2016**  
**Expected End Date: June 27, 2017**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto's work to upgrade the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Bathurst Street from Lake Shore Boulevard West to Queens Quay West is nearly complete.

We appreciate your patience while we continue to work to improve the City's Infrastructure.

The City will have to return in the fall of 2017 to complete watermain work that will make connections to Bathurst Street, Eireann Quay and Queen's Quay. This work is scheduled in the fall, when high lake-water and groundwater levels will subside enough to allow the work to take place efficiently. This work will take about 8 weeks to complete.

### WORK DETAILS

**To date, the following works has been completed:**

- Watermain and water service installations on Bathurst Street from Lake Shore Boulevard to Queens Quay, and on Eireann Quay from Queens Quay to the south end; and
- Permanent watermain trench restoration on Eireann Quay from Queens Quay to the south end.

**From June 20 to 27 the contractor will:**

- remove fire hydrants and valves from the “old” watermain;
  - restore the road’s concrete foundation;
  - replace the damaged sidewalk and curb; and
  - repave affected lanes of traffic.
- Please note that this schedule is subject to change. We’ll provide a new notice for any schedule changes.


### WHAT'S NEW




Bathurst’s upcoming restoration work will require lane and sidewalk closures in order to complete the work in a safe manner. Please obey all road- and construction signage.

Police officers will be on site during the day to control traffic during closure of the southbound Bathurst curb lane. For safety and smooth traffic flow, please obey direction off Police officers on site.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b></p> <p><b>Daytime: Tuesday June 20 to Tuesday June 27 from 9am to 3 pm.</b></p> <p><b>Night-time: Friday June 23, 2017 from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.</b></p> <p><b>Weekend: Saturday June 24, 2017 from 6:00 am to 3 pm.</b></p> <p>Overnight work allows the road to remain open and free of work during the day and reduces the interruption to TTC Streetcar service in the community.</p> <p>Please see the schedule of upcoming work above for detailed work-hour information.</p>
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	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Please see the schedule above for anticipated road and sidewalk impacts.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>

	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner.
