Watermain Replacement on Bathurst Street and Eireann Quay

Contract: 16ECS-LU-03SU

Start Date: September 6, 2016

Expected End Date: May, 2017*

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Eireann Quay and on Bathurst from Lakeshore Boulevard to Queens Quay continues.

We appreciate your patience while we continue to work on watermain replacement.

WORK DETAILS

To date, the following work has been completed:

- Watermain and water service installation is complete on Bathurst Street from Lake Shore Boulevard to Queens Quay, and on Eireann Quay from Queens Quay to the south end

Work scheduled for Spring:





- The Contractor will be returning in Spring to:
 - remove fire hydrants and valves from the "old" watermain;
 - restore the road's concrete foundation;
 - replace the damaged sidewalk and curb; and
 - repave affected lanes of traffic.

Another Construction Notice will be sent with a detailed schedule before work resumes.

WHAT'S NEW

This original contract called for the work to install the watermain at the intersection of Bathurst and Queens Quay. This portion of the work will be re-tendered and will not be delivered until later this year. Appropriate information about this portion of work will be sent when it is available.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Work Hours: Most work will take place from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday night to Friday night with some work during the day on weekends as required (9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.).</p> <p>Overnight work allows the road to remain open and free of work during the day and reduces the interruption to TTC Streetcar service in the community.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p>As a part of this work, southbound lanes on Bathurst will typically be closed from Lake Shore Boulevard West to Queens Quay, from 10:00pm to 6:00 am, Monday night to Friday night.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
