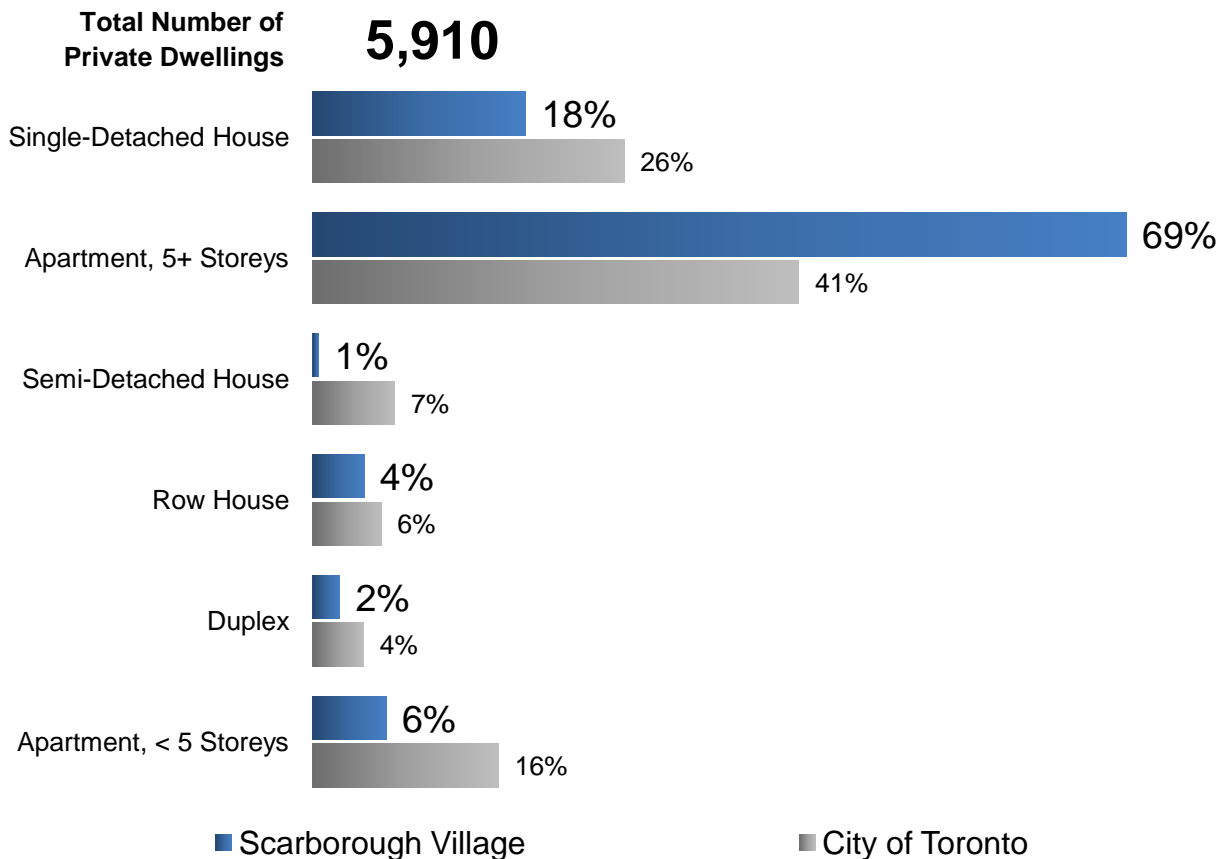

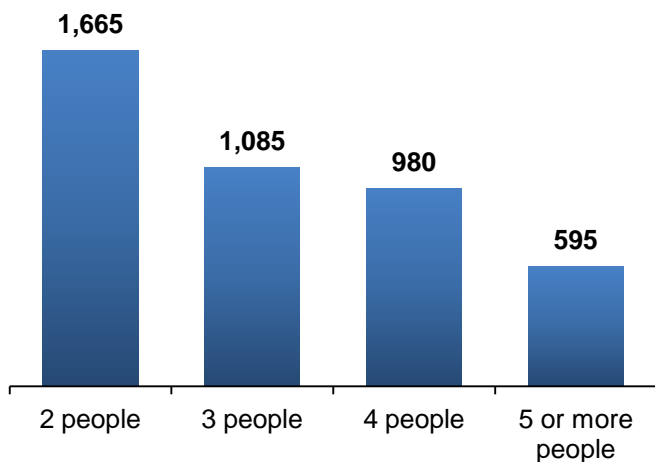

## Number of Census Families by Size of Family



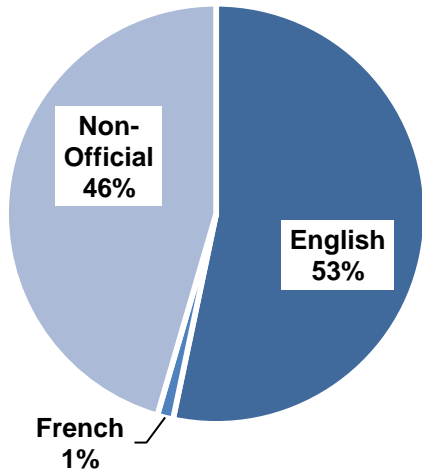

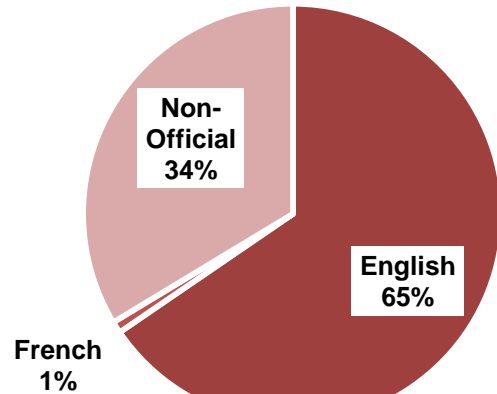

## Mother Tongue (Single-Response)



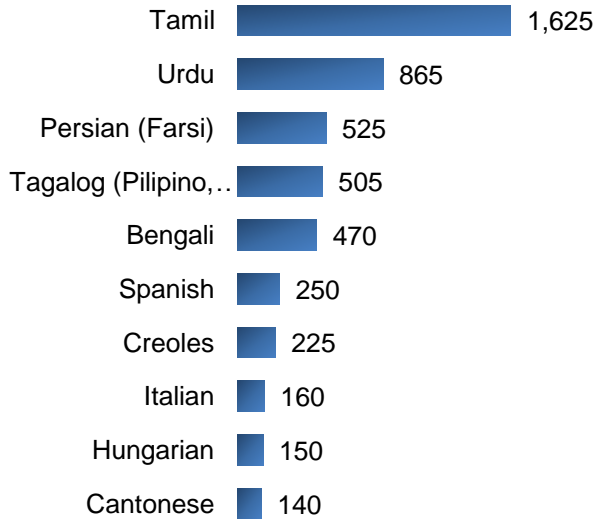

## Home Language (Single-Response)

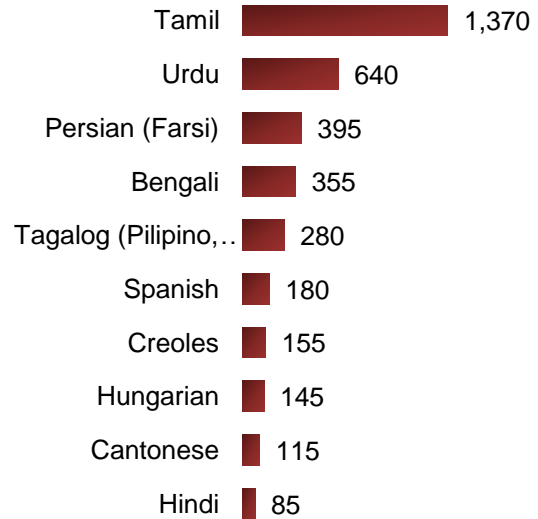

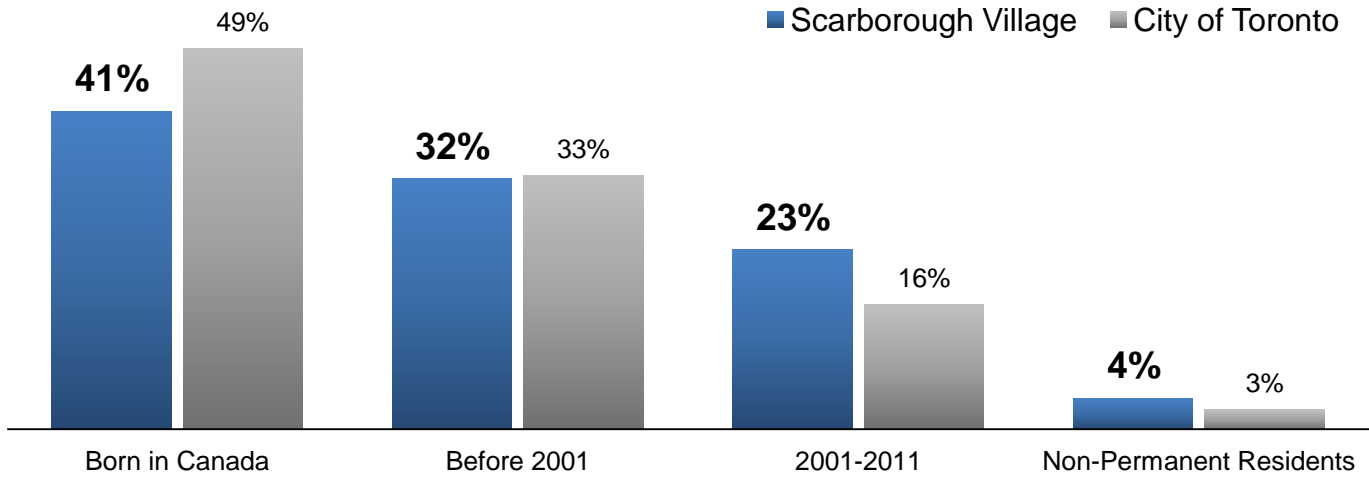
## Knowledge of Official Languages



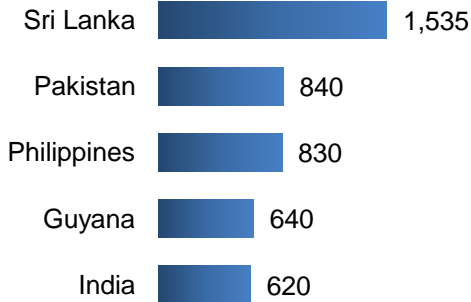

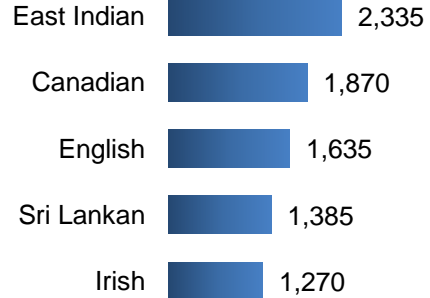
## Period of Immigration



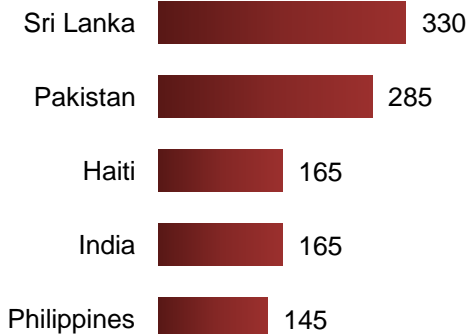
## Top-5 Birth Country for All Immigrants



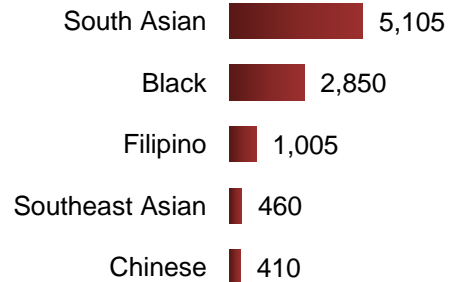
## Top-5 Ethnic Origins

## Top-5 Visible Minority Group

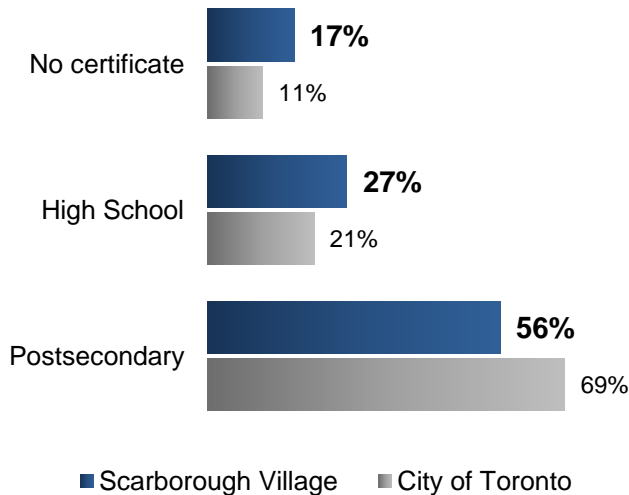

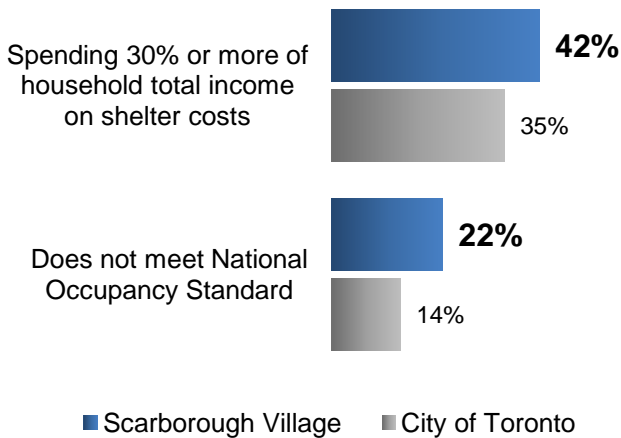
### Highest Educational Attainment for Pop Age 25-64 Yrs

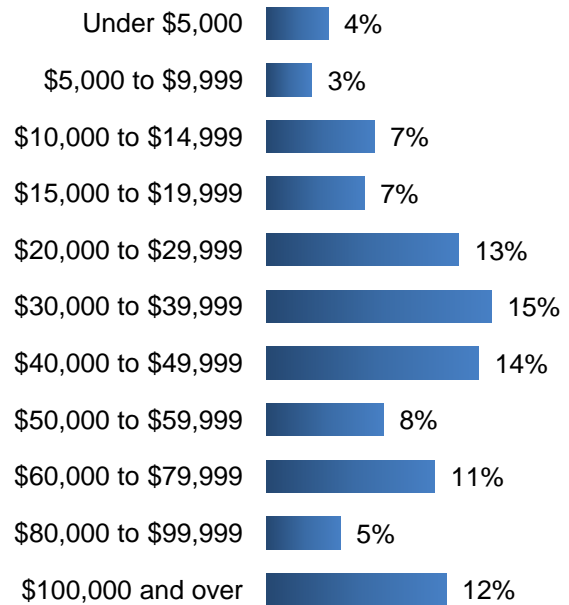
