
Watermain Replacement on Bedford Road From Machperson Avenue to Bernard Avenue

Contract: 15ECS-LU-01TT
Start Date: February 2016
Original End Date: December 30, 2016
Revised End Date: May 31, 2017

The City of Toronto's work replacing and re-lining the watermain on Bedford Road between Bernard Avenue and Macpherson Avenue is progressing well.

While work has progressed well, a delay was encountered because it took longer than the expected time for Bell, Rogers and Toronto Hydro to relocate their underground services. These utility providers had to move their services before the tunneling work could start on this project. The new, expected completion date is May 31, 2017. We appreciate your patience and understanding of this delay to our end date.

• The watermain lining from Macpherson Ave. to Dupont St. below the railway tracks, is complete



Construction Update #2

- Tunneling to install the remaining portion of the watermain between Bernard Avenue and Dupont Street started in December 2016 and should be completed by April 2017
- When the tunnelling is complete, Bedford Road will be reopened to traffic in both directions.
- Pressure testing, disinfection and restoration will occur near end of the project.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with occasional work after hours and on weekends as required to shorten the project duration.



Water Service Disruptions: At this time, water service disruption is not anticipated. However, if the water supply to your property requires shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the tunneling work through the tunnel shaft, the southbound lane on Bedford Road between Bernard Avenue and Davenport Avenue will remain closed until April 30 2017. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.



Restoration: areas affected by the construction work area will be restored



TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 26 Dupont Bus route. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.
