The City of Toronto is planning to resurface the road on Huron Street from Dundas Street to the Lane North of Dundas and West of Beverley Street. This work is required to improve the quality of the street, sidewalk and pedestrian environment. Physical improvements will be installed on the sidewalk areas including Chinese Zodiac lanterns, Octagonal benches, Filigree Light Poles and Chinese art works.



WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins
 with more information about the work.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways, municipal sidewalks and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and or decorative objects before work starts. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager listed below.
