# High Level Substation Rehabilitation at 235 Cottingham Street

#### Contract: MCP-13-27WP Expected Start Date: August 15, 2016 Expected End Date: May 31, 2017 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the electrical substation located in the High Level Pumping Station Park starting mid-August 2016. This work will ensure that the substation continues to provide long-term reliable service, and is part of the Council-approved 2016 Capital Works Program.

## WORK DETAILS

In the first few weeks, the City's contractor will move equipment on-site and prepare the work area before construction begins. Construction crews will then:

- Construct a temporary substation to maintain continuous pumping station operation.
- Demolish and remove the existing electrical substation located in the High Level Park.
- Reconstruct the new substation in the same location at High Level Park.
- Improve the wall around the substation.
- Restore grass to the park.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<b>Work Hours</b> : Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends, if required.
÷	<b>Park Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, the west section of the park will be closed during construction. There will be temporary fencing around the construction site to protect the public. Residents looking to visit the open section of the park will be able to do so from the north only. (See map for reference).
8	<b>Traffic Management</b> : Efforts have been made to minimize disruption of traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect minimal delays with some minor increase in traffic on nearby main and side streets.
	<b>Restoration:</b> The construction area will be restored with sod and asphalt where required. Sod will be laid in the spring (April to June), during optimal growing conditions.
