Watermain Replacement on Don Mills Road from Lawrence Ave. E to The Donway & Road Resurfacing from Lawrence Ave. to Wynford Drive

Expected Start Date: July 31, 2017
End Date: December 31, 2017

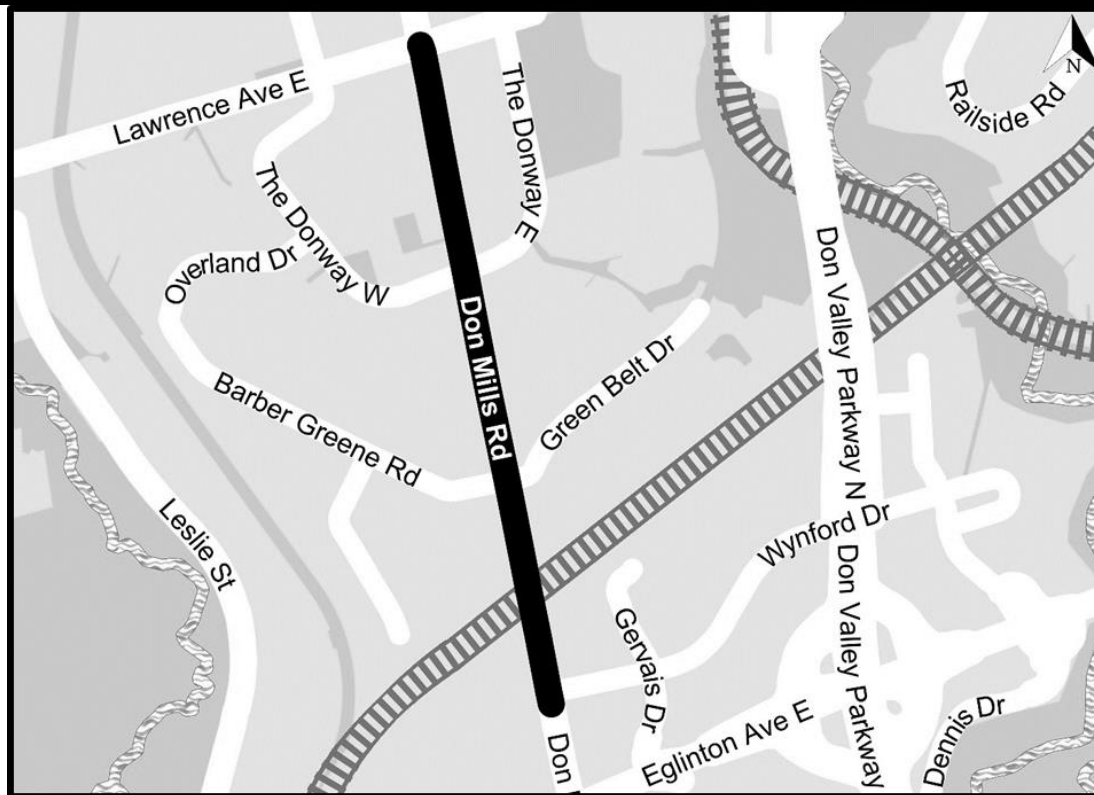
The City of Toronto will replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Don Mills Road from Lawrence Ave. E to The Donway starting in late July.

The water service is the underground pipe that brings water to your water meter and is owned by you and by the City. The part you own is from your house to the end of your property, the part the City owns is from the end of your property to the watermain.

The City of Toronto will also resurface Don Mills Road from about 80 metres north of Lawrence Ave. E. to Wynford Drive. The work will include the intersection of Don Mills Road and Wynford Drive subject to Metrolinx's work. The City will not resurface the intersection of Don Mills Road and Barber Greene/Green Belt Dr.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2017 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk of watermain breaks.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Excavate the road and dig a trench to access and install the new watermain
- Replace any City-owned water service pipes that do not meet City standards from the watermain to the private property line
- Restore all areas affected by construction
- Resurface the road








The project will be done in two phases:

Phase 1 – Watermain replacement from Lawrence Ave E to The Donway, including the temporary restoration.

Phase 2 – Road resurfacing from Wynford Dr. to about 80 metres north of Lawrence Ave E.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 11:00 pm., Monday to Friday; 9:00 am to 9:00 pm., Saturday and Sunday.</p>
	<p>Water Service Disruptions: From time-to-time, the water supply to your property will be shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not receive advanced notice, an emergency water shut off could have been necessary.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Traffic on Don Mills Road may be reduced to one southbound lane during the watermain installation from 9:30a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Two lanes must be available in the morning and afternoon rush hours</p> <p>When the road is being resurfaced, traffic may be reduced to one lane in the direction of paving operation.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
