The Guild Park and Gardens is a place with important community resources. The Guild includes heritage and cultural assets, many hectares of natural forest, and several kilometers of trails with vistas to Lake Ontario. This meeting will be a brief presentation followed by workshop style table discussions on the themes of the management plan:
