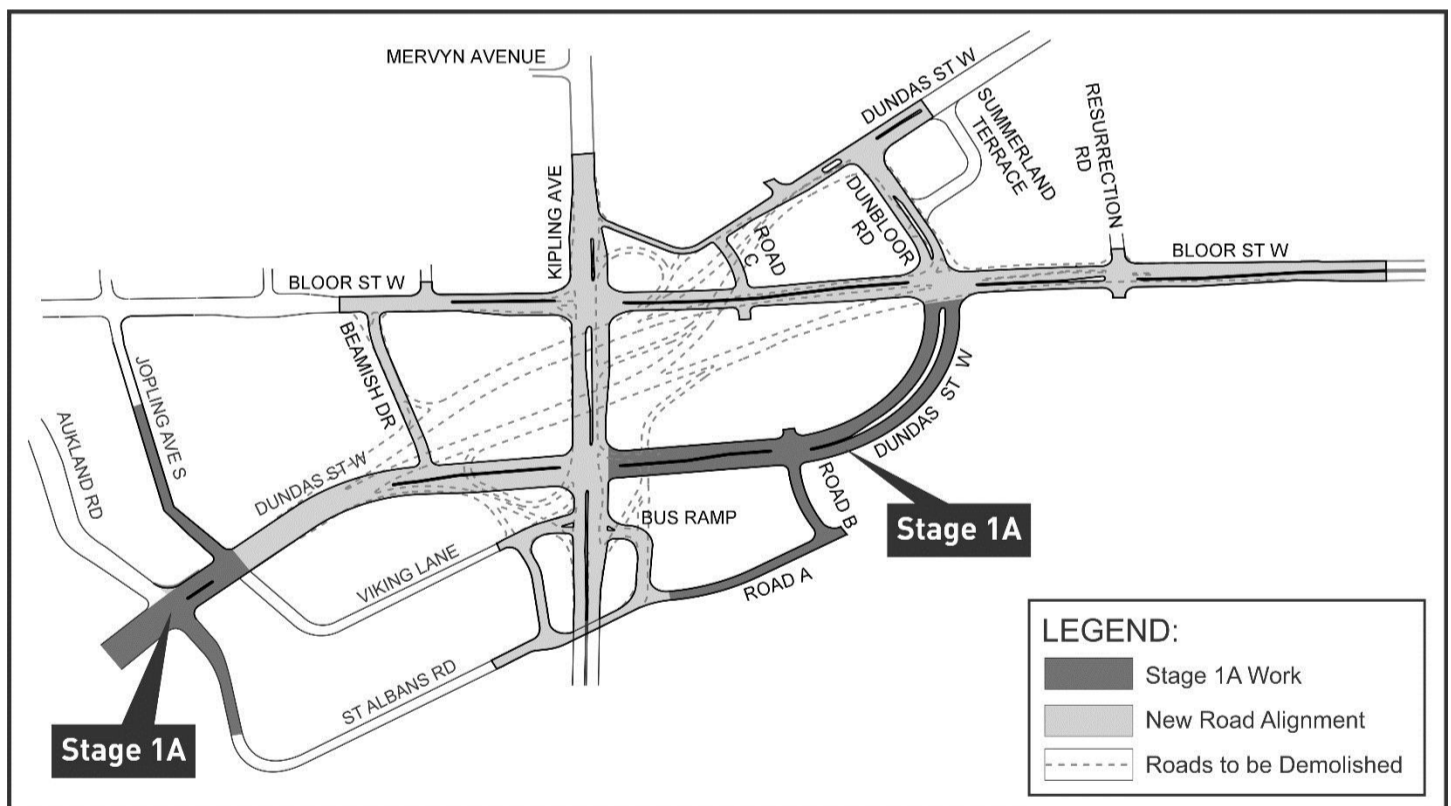
The City of Toronto has started Stage 1 construction of the Six Points Interchange Reconfiguration. Work during this stage is taking place within the Westwood Theatre lands, and on Dundas Street West (see map below).

This project is part of the Council-approved 2016 - 2025 Capital Budget and Plan, and supports the development of Etobicoke Centre as a vibrant mixed-use transit-oriented community. A detailed schedule of work to be completed at future stages will be shared at a public event in the Spring of 2017.

Construction is taking place in 2 phases. Phase 1 took place from 2014 – 2016 and prepared for the new road alignment within the Westwood Theatre Lands. Phase 2 of construction starts in March 2017 and will be divided into various stages (i.e. Stages 1 – 3) taking place in different sections of the project area. WORK DETAILS

Stage 1 has been broken down into multiple phases (A) through (D). The work for Stage 1A is outlined below and shown on the work area map above.

Stage	Dates	Work
1A	March – December	<p>Construct the new Dundas Street West alignment which involves installing new watermains, storm water sewers, sanitary sewers, streetscaping (including landscaping, street lighting and underground utilities), road resurfacing and curb installation.</p> <p>Constructing an underground Hydro duct bank on Dundas Street West in the roadway from Auckland Road, to Jopling Avenue and restoring the road when complete.</p>

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and / or decorative objects. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the Project Manager.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>For Stage 1A:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Construction of new Dundas St. alignment between Kipling Ave. to Bloor St. W. will occur through the old Westwood Theatre property and have minimal public traffic impact. • Construction of new hydro duct banks from Aukland Rd to Jopling Ave will be within the existing roadway. Road crossings will require lane reductions. <p>Additional traffic management information will be communicated about future Stage 1 work (i.e. Stages 1B through 1D) as the construction progresses.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required in future stages of the work. Updates will be provided.</p>
	<p>Transit Service: This project will affect travel times of ALL TTC and Mississauga Transit Routes to and from Kipling Subway Station that travel along Dundas Street West.</p> <p>Visit ttc.ca or mississauga.ca/portal/miway for accurate schedule information.</p>
